Approval to Use Public Facility Fees to Purchase Equipment and Software for Data Infrastructure Upgrades to Enhance Customer Service at the Stanislaus County Library Page 2

DISCUSSION:

The Stanislaus County Library strives to maintain and enhance services offered to its customers. The Stanislaus County Library plans to use Public Facility Fees (PFF) to upgrade its equipment and software in specific areas. These enhancements are identified due to the continual growth in public demand, and are necessary for the Library to maintain the needed level of customer service. This request has been presented to the PFF Committee and has received their required approval pertaining to the appropriate use of funds.

Since the inception of the PFF Program in 1990, and through Fiscal Year 2008-2009, the population in Stanislaus County has increased more than 50%. During the same period of time, wireless service was introduced and internet usage has increased by approximately 106%. The recommended upgrades will ensure that that data infrastructure at the Library will adequately serve the needs of the public.

Telephone Messaging System

Due to the increase in customers using the Library, there is a corresponding increase in the demand to send customer notifications for renewals, holds and past due information. To cope with the demand and to provide the same level of customer service, the Library has identified a proven automated system called Telephone Messaging 3 (TM3) to handle the delivery of notifications to customers. Since TM3 is directly linked to the Library's Horizon integrated system which hosts and maintains customer activities, TM3 will be able to provide real time customer information such as items on loan, items for renewal and outstanding past due status. The system also includes other capabilities such as auto re-dial and reports for tracking calls.

The total cost of the TM3 project is approximately \$26,580 of which \$8,690 is recommended to be funded through the use of PFF funds with the remainder being covered through the Library's existing administration budget.

Web and Spam Filters

In recent years, the Library has been experiencing a surge in internet usage. Statistics indicate that usage in the past fiscal year was up 5.5%. The Library has installed filters to monitor and ensure that customers, especially children, are not using the internet connection to access unwarranted websites. In order for the Library to handle the growth in customer usage and continue to provide customers with fast, safe and protected internet access, the Library must increase its filtering ability. This is also necessary to comply with the Federal E-rate discount program in which the Library participates.

The total cost for this upgrade is approximately \$7,000 of which \$2,290 is recommended to be funded through the use of PFF funds with the remainder being covered through the Library's existing administration budget.

Servers

Due to the surge in demand in internet and wireless usages in all of the thirteen library branches, the Library must add four servers to the existing system in order to effectively accommodate the growing demand. The estimated cost of one server is \$2,500.

The total estimated cost of purchasing four services is approximately \$10,000 of which the entire amount is recommended to be funded through the use of PFF funds.

Software for Email

The Library sends out monthly newsletter using a software program called List Manager. The license for List Manager has a limit of generating 10,000 emails per month and customer requests have already reached its capacity. With increasing public interest about library services, the Library must expand the capacity of the software in order to keep up with on-going, growing customer demand.

The approximate cost of this software is \$3,000 of which the entire amount is recommended to be funded through the use of PFF funds.

There are sufficient funds in the Library's PFF fund to absorb this request. In order for the Library to continue to offer its services to the public, it must be equipped with the appropriate resources. The recommendation for use of PFF funds to purchase equipment and software for data infrastructure upgrades to enhance customer service, due to growth, is appropriate and consistent with the plan for the use of these funds.

POLICY ISSUE:

The Board of Supervisors should determine if approval of the recommended actions is consistent with its priorities of striving for a strong local economy and the efficient delivery of public services.
