Approval to Declare Heavy Equipment and Miscellaneous Parts from the Department of Public Works as Surplus and Authorize the Sale Page 2

DISCUSSION:

It is recommended that the Board approve this request to declare as surplus, the attached list of equipment and misc. parts, and authorize the disposal.

County Ordinance 2.24.065 allows for the sale of surplus property with a residual value greater than one thousand dollars upon approval by the Board of Supervisors.

2.24.065 Sale of personal property.

The purchasing agent is authorized to sell, trade, trade in, lease, exchange, or otherwise dispose of any personal property belonging to the county which is deemed to be surplus and not required for public use by the county and which has a value of less than one thousand dollars per individual item without prior approval by the board of supervisors. Notwithstanding any other provision of this code, such disposition of surplus property may be made without securing bids or advertising. For disposition of personal property exceeding one thousand dollars per individual item, prior approval from the board of supervisors must be obtained. All proceeds from such sales shall be paid into the county treasury for the use of the county. (Ord. CS 475 §3, 1992).

Because of changing regulations with the Air Resources Board, the equipment has been retired from the County fleet in order to meet compliance.

All equipment and misc. parts have been retired since October 2009. The cost to retrofit the equipment in the attached list, far exceeds the value of the equipment. The entire list of equipment and parts have out lived there usefulness and are no longer of use to any county department. Therefore, the request is being made to dispose of all the items on the attached spreadsheet in one of three ways:

- Release To Auction Company (Ernst)
- Sale on Government Website
- County Surplus Sale

There will be no cost to the County to sell either by auctioneer or government website, the entire cost is borne by the buyer. The net proceeds from the sale of these vehicles will return to the Department of Public Works — Morgan Shop Division.

Department of Public Works is requesting that the proceeds of the auction, estimated at \$30,000, be directed to the Department of Public Works, account #5121-42100-40400.

A County Surplus Sale would require the selling department to encounter certain small fees such as, placing an ad in the local paper or other miscellaneous fees if necessary, which will be offset by the revenue from the sale.
