## **DISCUSSION:**

It is recommended that the Board approve the request to declare as surplus, the attached list of County vehicles, and authorize their sale. These vehicles have outlived their useful life and no longer have value as County assets.

County Ordinance 2.24.065 allows for the sale of surplus property with a residual value greater than one thousand dollars upon approval by the Board of Supervisors.

#### 2.24.065 Sale of personal property.

The purchasing agent is authorized to sell, trade, trade in, lease, exchange, or otherwise dispose of any personal property belonging to the county which is deemed to be surplus and not required for public use by the county and which has a value of less than one thousand dollars per individual item without prior approval by the board of supervisors. Notwithstanding any other provision of this code, such disposition of surplus property may be made without securing bids or advertising. For disposition of personal property exceeding one thousand dollars per individual item, prior approval from the board of supervisors must be obtained. All proceeds from such sales shall be paid into the county treasury for the use of the county. (Ord. CS 475 §3, 1992).

The attached list represents vehicles where the cost to repair the vehicle exceeds the value of the vehicle, or the vehicle is no longer of use to any county department. These vehicles will be turned over to an auction company, which will sell the vehicles and return the net proceeds to the General Services Agency (GSA) – Fleet Services Division. GSA – Fleet Services staff time and expenses incurred in processing vehicles will be deducted from the proceeds and deposited to 5021-18510-46000, prior to distribution of proceeds to departments.

## POLICY ISSUES:

This agenda item is consistent with the Board of Supervisors' priority of Efficient delivery of public services.

#### STAFFING IMPACT:

There is no staffing impact associated with this agenda item. Transfer of vehicles to auction and associated paperwork will be done within current GSA – Fleet Services staffing.
