Approval for the City of Modesto to Have Exclusive Use of the Courthouse Lawn on May 15, 2010, for their Fifteenth Annual Family Cycling Event Festival

DISCUSSION:

A request has been received from the City of Modesto to have exclusive use of the Courthouse Lawn for their Fifteenth Annual Family Cycling Festival on Saturday, May 15, 2010, beginning 7:00 a.m., and ending no later than 6:00 p.m. The Courthouse Lawn serves as an essential community open-space area within the downtown corridor of the City of Modesto and is highly valued as a community event location.

The City of Modesto's Family Cycling Festival is in its fifteenth year. The Fifteenth Family Cycling Festival is held during the California Bike Commute Week and is a free community event with bicycle races for children, bicycle safety information, cycling entertainment, and a variety of activities for the whole family. The California Bike Commute Week is sponsored by the California Bicycle Coalition that advocates for the use of bicycles as an alternative form of transportation.

The Department supports this request for exclusive use providing the City of Modesto adheres to the following requirements:

- The City of Modesto shall provide the Department of Parks and Recreation a Certificate of Insurance with a minimum of \$1 million liability coverage and shall provide accompanying endorsements naming Stanislaus County as an additional insured. The Certificate of Insurance shall be provided no later than 5:00 p.m., Wednesday, May 12, 2010.
- An Organization Hold Harmless Agreement is required. The original must be completed and returned no later than 5:00 p.m., Wednesday, May 12, 2010.
- All vendors are required to have proper permits, licenses, and insurance.
- No portable toilets shall be placed on any lawn area of the courthouse; placement shall be only on concrete or paved surface.
- The expected number of participants is 2,000.
- No alcohol may be sold or served during this exclusive use.
- The City of Modesto shall provide all security personnel for this exclusive use event.
- The Courthouse Lawn area shall be left free of litter, debris, and garbage and all shall be removed from the premises.
- Any damages to the facility shall be reported immediately to the Department.
