ORDINANCE NO. C.S. 1087

**AN ORDINANCE INCREASING EXISTING FEES
COLLECTED BY THE SHERIFF'S DEPARTMENT FOR
FINGERPRINT PROCESSING**

THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF STANISLAUS, STATE OF CALIFORNIA, ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Section 4.54.010 and Section 4.54.020 of the Stanislaus County code are amended to read as follows:

"Section 4.54.010. Whereas California Penal Code Section 13300, at subdivision (e) authorizes the imposition of a fee to cover the cost of taking fingerprints and processing required documents, and it is the intent of the Board of Supervisors to adopt this chapter to establish such fee.

Section 4.54.020. Whereas the Board of Supervisors held a public meeting pursuant to California Government Code Section 54986 for the consideration and approval of a fee to cover the costs of taking fingerprints and processing the required documents associated with fingerprints in the amount of fifteen dollars, and based upon the data presented to said board, it adopts a fingerprint fee pursuant to California Penal Code Section 13300, subdivision (e) in the amount of fifteen dollars for such service."

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect thirty (30) days from and after the date of its passage and before the expiration of fifteen (15) days after its passage it shall be published once, with the names of the members voting for and against the same, in the Modesto Bee, a newspaper published in the County of Stanislaus, State of California.
