Geer Road at Santa Fe Avenue Intersection Improvement Project will be funded 100% by Regional Transportation Impact Fee (RTIF) funds. At this time, \$96,782 is needed for additional engineering services to complete the Geer Road at Santa Fe Avenue Intersection Improvement Project. Amendment No. 4 brings the total amount of Agreement 2004-1 with BkF Engineering to \$607,132 for completion of both projects under this contract.

DISCUSSION:

In January 2004, the Board of Supervisors approved the Public Works Road Congestion Relief Program. Two of the projects approved under this program were the improvements of the Geer Road at Santa Fe Avenue intersection and the Hatch Road at Santa Fe Avenue intersection. The proposed improvements consist of traffic signals, installation of left turn lanes, upgrade to the railroad signals and crossings, pavement widening, traffic striping, and expansion of the existing bridge on Santa Fe Avenue near Hatch Road.

In May 2004, the Board of Supervisors awarded a contract to BkF Engineers for engineering services for the Geer Road at Santa Fe Avenue and Hatch Road at Santa Fe Avenue Intersection Improvement Projects.

In June 2006, the Board of Supervisors approved Amendment No. 1 with BkF Engineers for additional engineering services for the design of the bridge on Santa Fe Avenue at Hatch Road and preparation of environmental clearance documents.

In July 2007, the Board of Supervisors approved Amendment No. 2 with BkF Engineers for additional engineering services for the improvements at Geer Road at Santa Fe

Avenue and Hatch Road at Santa Fe Avenue. These additional engineering services included the preparation of individual specifications and plans for each intersection and plans and specifications for the bridge on Santa Fe Avenue.

On August 28, 2007, the Board of Supervisors adopted the Mitigated Negative Declaration for the Stanislaus County intersection improvements at Geer Road at Santa Fe Avenue and Hatch Road at Santa Fe Avenue. Also approved were the purchase agreements to acquire road right-of-way associated with the project. On June 27, 2008, the Department of Public Works certified that all necessary right-of-way for the bridge improvements on Santa Fe Avenue near Hatch Road had been obtained.

On July 22, 2008, the Board of Supervisors approved and adopted the plans and specifications for the Stanislaus County Intersection Improvements – Phase 2: Santa Fe Avenue Bridge Widening and Retrofit Project and directed the Clerk to publish the notice inviting bids.

On October 21, 2008, the Board of Supervisors awarded the contract to Agee Construction Corporation of Clovis, California for the Stanislaus County Intersection Improvements – Phase 2: Santa Fe Avenue Bridge Widening and Retrofit Project. On February 11, 2009, the construction of the bridge was completed and a notice of completion was recorded.

On April 14, 2009, the Board of Supervisors approved Amendment No. 3 with BkF Engineers to add additional engineering services for the Hatch Road at Santa Fe Avenue improvement project. The work included redesign of the bridge and construction support services.

In order to proceed with the Geer Road at Santa Fe Avenue Intersection Improvement project, Stanislaus County will need to acquire right-of-way from the parcel at the northwest corner of Geer Road and Santa Fe Avenue. After discussions with the property owner and discussions within Public Works, it was determined it would be mutually beneficial to both parties to acquire the ultimate right-of-way along the Northwest parcel and move the traffic to the outside lanes along Geer Road and Santa Fe Avenue frontages of the property. This change requires re-design of the northwest corner of the intersection, including transitions from the existing to the proposed roadway. On March 29, 2010, BkF Engineers submitted a proposal to perform this work in the amount of \$96,782. Public Works staff has reviewed the proposal and concur with their scope of work, costs, and schedule. Construction is tentatively scheduled to begin in the summer of 2011.

Proposal for Additional Engineering Services

Road Congestion Relief Projects - Stanislaus County, California

Dear Mr. Song:

BKF has been requested to provide additional services outside our original scope of work. During a meeting on October 27, 2009, the County described revisions to the road layouts of Geer Road and Santa Fe Avenue. As a result of entitlement negotiations between the County and the developer of the Ruddy property, it was decided that Geer Road should be widened to a right-of-way width of 135 feet and that Santa Fe Avenue should be widened to a right-of-way width of 85 feet along the Ruddy property frontages to accommodate the ultimate roadway cross sections. The County intends to widen the two roads along the Ruddy property frontages and construct curb, gutter, and drainage improvements. The County provided a concept plan on March 1, 2010, which illustrates the County's intent for improvements and lane configurations. BKF has been requested to revise the current intersection improvement plans, specifications, and estimate (PS&E) to incorporate these new improvements.

Tasks associated with the requested revisions will include *Project Management / Meetings*, *Data Collection*, *Preliminary Design*, and *Final Design*. We anticipate 3 meetings with the County to review the project elements and documents at the milestone submittals. *Data Collection* will include up to 4 days of additional field survey to gather existing conditions topographic data for areas outside the previous project limits. *Data Collection* will also include two percolation test borings and associated report in support of the design of the new drainage systems. *Preliminary Design* will include submittal of 60% plans and estimate to the County for review and comment. *Final Design* will include submittals of 100% and Final (PS&E) to the County for plan check and approval/bid purposes. We estimate approximately 4 months to complete this process, as illustrated in the enclosed Draft Design Schedule.

BKF has estimated hours and associated fees to complete the described services. Please refer to the attached Cost Proposal.

As discussed, the County has expressed an interest in including a striped crosswalk across Geer Road just north of the intersection. BKF recommends that the County reconsider this request. First, none of the frontages are being completed with sidewalks so the crosswalk would not connect to pedestrian routes of travel. Second, adding a crosswalk to this intersection could result in numerous changes to the entire project, such as signal timing and phasing changes, level of service impacts, turn lane stacking distance changes, lengthening of lane transitions, additional right-of-way acquisition, and re-processing the project through the CPUC and BNSF railroad. If the County is interested in pursuing a crosswalk at this time, we recommend that a Feasibility Study be conducted to determine the potential impacts. Based on the numerous potential impacts, a rough order of magnitude cost to provide the Feasibility Study is \$30,000. This includes 180



hours of time between myself (20 hours), Alex Heuer (80 hours), and Jeff Wang (80 hours), our Traffic Manager and Chief Geometrician. This cost would also include additional traffic counts at this intersection and other reimbursable expenses. The attached Cost Proposal does not include the design of the crosswalk or the effort for the Feasibility Study.
