Approval of Fiscal Year 2010-2011 Renewal Agreements for Contracted Program Services for Individuals and Families Receiving Temporary Aid to Needy Families, CalWORKs, Child Welfare, and Adult Services Page 2

DISCUSSION:

The Community Services Agency (CSA) relies on many partner agencies to provide services to individuals and families receiving Temporary Aid to Needy Families (TANF), CalWORKs, Child Welfare Services, Adult Services and support for business operations. These agencies provide a wide range of mostly mandated services designed to: provide court ordered evaluations and treatment; train new foster parents, facilitate the Independent Living Skills Program; provide mandated emergency protective services for adult clients; and to provide administrative and operating services.

CSA requests Board of Supervisors approval to renew contracts with the 29 vendors listed on Attachments 1 and 2.

Some of the Expected Outcomes include:

- Approximately 500 TANF Welfare To Work participants will receive employment services moving themselves and their families towards self-sufficiency;
- Approximately 1,571 children and families will receive mandated or court ordered services; and
- Approximately 1850 adults will receive mandated emergency protective services.

As required by the Board of Supervisors on January 24, 2006, Attachment 1 includes those agreements that have a cumulative value that exceeds \$100,000 for the period beginning July 1, 2003 through June 30, 2011. The total amount of the contacts to be renewed through this Agenda item is \$8,877,555. CSA will identify any amendments to the Fiscal Year 2010-2011 agreements in future quarterly reports to the Board of Supervisors.

In addition, County departments are required to submit quarterly reports to the Board of any new or existing agreement where the compensation exceeds \$50,000 but does not exceed \$100,000, and the contract has not been previously approved by the Board of Supervisors. These contracts are identified in Attachment 2.

Approval of the agreements listed on Attachments 1 and 2 will enable the Community Services Agency to provide court ordered or mandated services that protect at risk children and adults in Stanislaus County through coordinated activities with other agencies and in collaboration with the community help foster parents and improve administrative support services.

POLICY ISSUE:

Approval of these agreements supports the Board's priority of A Healthy Community, Effective Partnerships and Efficient Delivery of Public Services by contracting with vendors to deliver services that support families and keep children and elderly in the community safe.
