## FISCAL IMPACT (Continued):

Proposed commercial bin rate adjustments range from a 0.52% decrease to a 2.00% decrease. Proposed franchise drop-box haul charge adjustments range from a 1.40% decrease to a 3.22% decrease.

In addition, residents and businesses that wish to utilize 3- or 4-yard commercial bins for seven-day periods to perform clean-ups or minor construction/demolition projects performed by the property or business owner/occupant, may see charges of \$66, or \$65 respectively, for the seven-day rental period. These charges include dumping the bin one time. Additionally, in the case of Franchise Area 2, a special on-call charge at the rate of \$140 per hour is charged in addition to disposal charges at the established rate, to provide collection services of the 4-yard bins at the Woodward Reservoir; a charge which is unique to Woodward Reservoir because of the seasonal nature of this facility and its use of bins at this site. While the seven-day rentals and the on-call reservoir service have previously existed, these rates have not been previously established by the Board.

#### **DISCUSSION:**

### Franchise Areas 1, 2, and 4

Through much of 2008, Department of Environmental Resources staff worked with the consulting firm of Hilton, Farnkopf & Hobson, LLC, and the franchise refuse collection companies to develop new "base" solid waste collection rates (Base Rates). Costs related to curbside recycling and the bulky item program are included in the residential Base Rates.

On November 4, 2008, the Board of Supervisors adopted new Base Rates from which the maximum franchise rates for solid waste collection services (hereinafter also referred to as "Rates") in the unincorporated areas of Stanislaus County would be set beginning July 1, 2009. At the same meeting, the Board also approved a new methodology for the annual adjustment of these Base Rates. For four consecutive years, beginning with July 1, 2009, the Base Rates may be increased or decreased only by the change in a series of consumer and other price indexes. Every fifth year, a detailed cost of service study will be repeated to determine new Base Rates, followed by another four years of index-based adjustments, and so on.

On June 30, 2009, the Board, following a public hearing, approved the first index-based adjustments in setting the maximum franchise rates for solid waste collection services for 2009-2010. Currently, Stanislaus County is in the second year of the index-based adjustments. The following indices and their respective changes (i.e., the difference between the April 2008 – March 2009 average, and the April 2009 – March 2010 average) have been applied to the indicated components of the individual companies' residential and commercial 2009-2010 Rates to calculate the proposed 2010-2011 Rates. Only the labor, fuel, collections, and interest adjustments have been applied to the Drop Box 2009-2010 Rates because the County sets only the haul charges for these services. Disposal, transfer, and franchise fees are billed to the customer directly by the companies as part of the service charge.

\*When the projected total compensation increases or decreases based on the net of the adjustments listed above, the expense included in the proposed rates for Franchise Fees must also be increased or decreased. This Component is included to make the franchise haulers "whole" at covering the exact amount of the County's 8% franchise fee.

It should be noted that the current Rate Adjustment Process "caps" rate adjustments, up or down, at 5% per annum. The cap had no impact on the proposed 2010-2011 Rates since the overall percentage change in the rates of all companies is less than 5%.

The proposed residential, commercial, and drop box rates (See Attachment A) are presented in a format that identifies the following: the change between the approved 2009-2010 Rates and the proposed 2010-2011 Rates with the appropriate indices applied. The proposed rates for seven-day bin rentals and the on-call reservoir service are included in Attachment A.

#### Franchise Area 3

On August 11, 2009, the Board approved the award of Franchise Refuse Collection Area #3 to Turlock Scavenger Company, effective November 1, 2009. This award was the result of a competitive procurement that began in November of 2008.

The respondents to the February 2009 Request for Proposals (RFP), including Turlock Scavenger, were asked to bid total compensation requirements for the initial 31.8 months of

the contract period. Per the RFP and the Agreement with Turlock Scavenger, their rates will remain constant through June 30, 2012. Therefore, an adjustment in the rates for Franchise Area 3 is not proposed for 2010-2011, and the rates are included (Attachment B) for informational purposes only. The Board approved these maximum rates for refuse collection on October 27, 2009, following a public hearing.

#### **POLICY ISSUE:**

The Board of Supervisors is required to set a public hearing prior to adjusting the maximum rates for solid waste collection services. After the public hearing, the rates could be changed. The Board should determine if adjusting the maximum rates for solid waste collection services is consistent with its priorities of a safe community, a healthy community, and a well-planned infrastructure system.
