Approval to Accept Additional Fiscal Year 2009-2010 Funding for the Health Insurance Counseling Advocacy Program (HICAP) From the California Department of Aging Page 2

DISCUSSION:

On June 15, 2010, a Program Memo was received from the California Department of Aging (CDA) notifying the Area Agency on Aging (AAA) that additional funding in the amount of \$10,540 is available to provide increased services for Health Insurance Counseling Advocacy Program (HICAP) clients. HICAP provides counseling to Medicare beneficiaries of all ages, by phone, office appointment or home visits for shut-ins. The program also includes community education presentations to organizations interested in health insurance issues affecting seniors and the disabled. HICAP services are free of charge and are provided by counselors that are trained and registered by CDA.

The AAA is proposing to use the additional funds to purchase computer hardware and software that will be used by newly certified HICAP Volunteer Counselors to provide assistance services to Medicare beneficiaries. As a result, the number of Medicare clients who will be seen on any given day will be increased, reducing the 'wait time' for an appointment.

POLICY ISSUE:

By accepting this additional Fiscal Year 2009-2010 funding from the California Department of Aging, the Area Agency on Aging will be able to provide assistance to more Medicare clients on a daily basis, consistent with the Board's priority of A Healthy Community.

STAFFING IMPACTS:

Existing Agency staff will administer the additional funding in support of HICAP.
