WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Turlock called a General Municipal Election to be held on November 2, 2010, in the City of Turlock, California, for the purpose of the election of two (2) Members of the City Council and a one (1) Mayor; and

WHEREAS, it is desirable that the that the General Municipal Election be consolidated with the Statewide General Municipal Election to be held on the same date and that within the City the precincts, polling places, and election officers of the two elections be the same, and that the county election department of the County of Stanislaus canvass the returns of the General Municipal Election and that the election be held in all respects as if there were only one election;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF TURLOCK DOES RESOLVE, DECLARE AND ORDER AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That pursuant to the requirements of §10403 of the Elections Code, the Board of Supervisors of the County of Stanislaus is hereby requested to consent and agree to the consolidation of a General Municipal Election with the Statewide General Election on Tuesday, November 2, 2010, for the purpose of the election of one (1) Mayor and two (2) Members of the City Council for 4-year terms of office which will conclude upon the Turlock City Council adopting the official canvass of the November 4, 2014, election.

Section 2. That the county election department is authorized to verify signatures for nomination papers submitted by the City Clerk of the City of Turlock; set up and arrange for election precincts, polling places, voting booths, and election officers; publish notice of election officers and polling places; canvas the returns of the General Municipal Election and the election shall be held in all respects as if there were only one election, and only one form of ballot shall be used.

Section 3. That the Board of Supervisors is requested to issue instructions to the county election department to take any and all steps necessary for the holding of the consolidated election.

Section 4. That the City of Turlock recognizes that additional costs will be incurred by the County by reason of this consolidation and agrees to reimburse the County for any costs.


Section 5. That the City Clerk is hereby directed to file a certified copy of this resolution with the Board of Supervisors and the county election department of the County of Stanislaus.

Section 6. That the City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this resolution and enter it into the book of original resolutions.
