Approval to Summarily Vacate the Easterly Thirty Feet of Lots 13, 14, 15 and 16 of the Reversion to Acreage Sturtevant Tract Map Recorded in Book 18 of Maps, Page 62, Located East of Michigan Avenue, in Stanislaus County

#### **DISCUSSION:**

The proposed area of abandonment was established from the Sturtevant Tract Map recorded in 1947, but was never developed. In 1956, a Reversion to Acreage Map was filed, reverting the surrounding property back to one parcel adjacent to Michigan Avenue. All adjacent lots affected by the abandonment have easements established through other parcels, providing access to Michigan Avenue; this removes the need for this right-of-way. The 30-foot right-of-way is not necessary for road purposes. This summary abandonment will return property use to all adjacent landowners. All utility companies involved agree to this summary abandonment.

#### **POLICY ISSUES:**

The Board of Supervisors should consider if the recommended action is consistent with its priority of striving for a Well Planned Infrastructure System.

Street and Highways Code 8333(a) states that the legislative body of a local agency may summarily vacate a public service easement if the easement has not been used for the purpose for which it was dedicated or acquired for five (5) consecutive years immediately preceding the proposed vacation.

Street and Highways Code 8333(c) states that that the legislative body of a local agency may summarily vacate a public service easement if the easement has been superseded by relocation, and there are no other public facilities located within the easement.

Street and Highways Code 8334(a) states that the legislative body of a local agency may summarily vacate excess right-of-way of a street or highway not required for street or highway purposes.

SUMMARILY VACATE THE EASTERLY THIRTY FEET OF LOTS 13, 14, 15 AND 16 OF THE REVERSION TO ACREAGE STURTEVANT TRACT MAP RECORDED IN BOOK 18 OF MAPS, PAGE 62, LOCATED EAST OF MICHIGAN AVENUE, IN STANISLAUS COUNTY

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Supervisors, of the County of Stanislaus, State of California, hereby finds and determines as follows:

- 1. In accordance with Section 8333(a) of the Street and Highway Code, the legislative body may summarily vacate a public utility easement if the easement has not been used for the purpose for which it was dedicated or acquired for five consecutive years immediately preceding the proposed vacation.
- 2. In accordance with Section 8333(c) of the Street and Highway Code, the legislative body may summarily vacate a public utility easement if the easement has been superceded by relocation, or determined to be excess by the easement holder, and there are no other public facilities located within the easement.
- 3. In accordance with Section 8334(a) of the Street and Highway Code, the legislative body may summarily vacate an excess right-of-way of a street or highway not required for street or highway purposes.
- 4. At the request of Patricia E. Barber, Stanislaus County is being requested to abandon a 30-foot portion of Lots 13, 14, 15, and 16 of Reversion to Acreage Sturtevant Tract Map, located east of Michigan Avenue in Stanislaus County, recorded in Volume 18 of Maps, Page 62, Stanislaus County Records.
- 5. AT&T, Pacific Gas & Electric, Modesto Irrigation District, and the City of Modesto have no facilities within the abandonment area and have no objections to the abandonment and we have no need for the easement.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that pursuant to the above Section 8333(a), 8333(c), and 8334(a), the easterly 30-foot portion of Lots 13, 14, 15, and 16 of the Reversion to Acreage Sturtevant Tract Map, located east of Michigan Avenue in Stanislaus County, recorded in Volume 18 of Maps, Page 62, Stanislaus County Records, are hereby summarily vacated.
