Approval of the Closure of the Riverbank Library on October 9, 2010, during the 34th Annual Riverbank Cheese and Wine Exposition Page 2

DISCUSSION:

The Riverbank Library, located at 3442 Santa Fe Street, is open to the public 38 hours per week: Monday 10:00 a.m.-5:00 p.m., Tuesday and Thursday 10:00 a.m.-6:00 p.m., Wednesday 10:00 a.m.-8:00 p.m., and Saturday 12:00-5:00 p.m.

For many years, the Riverbank Chamber of Commerce has used the area around the Library during their Cheese and Wine Exposition. This year, the Chamber is requesting the First Aid Station be located directly in front of the Riverbank Library. This location will provide easy public access and is located near the exposition Command Center.

Historically, this event has had quite an impact on the Riverbank Library. In the past when the library was open, there were constant lines of people waiting to use the restrooms with very little library business conducted during this weekend. The amount of supplies used by the public exceeded that which is normally provided by the custodial service. Additionally, it was almost impossible for Library staff to close the building at 5:00 p.m. due to the number of people in line waiting to use the restrooms.

Currently, the Library is scheduled to be open Saturday, October 9, 2010, from 12:00 p.m.-5:00 p.m.This year 60,000 people are expected to attend the Exposition. The Riverbank Rotary Club, the event sponsor, has recommended that the Library be closed Saturday, October 9, 2010. A signed Application and License for Temporary Use of Property is attached. The Riverbank Library has been closed for the past thirteen years during this event, and staff is recommending that it be closed again this year. Library staff will be present at a booth outside the Library to promote instant library card signups, library programs and services.

POLICY ISSUES:

The Board should determine whether closure of the Riverbank Library during the Riverbank Wine and Cheese Exposition is consistent with its priority of Effective Partnerships.

STAFFING IMPACT:

Library staff will be scheduled to work their regular Saturday shift at the library card sign-up and information table.

- 1. Licensor grants to Licensee and its employees, agents or contractors, a limited right of access to enter upon the Property for the purpose set forth above.
- 2. This License is for a limited period on the dates set forth above. The term of this License is not renewable, although the County, in its sole discretion, may grant additional, new licenses. This Agreement may be terminated by the County upon reasonable notice to the Licensee.
- 3. Licensee shall pay to the County as rent, a non-refundable fee in the amount of \$ 0.00 for of use of the Property during the license term.
- 4. Licensee shall not modify or alter the Property without prior written consent of the County. Licensee shall return the Property to its condition prior to such entry, except for reasonable wear and tear to the Property caused by the permitted use. Licensee shall keep the property free of liens and encumbrances, including mechanic's liens, arising out of the activities and conduct of the Licensee and Licensee's agents, employees and contractors.
- 5. Any entry upon the Property by Licensee, or Licensee's employees, agents or contractors, shall be at Licensee's sole risk and expense. The Licensees agree to assume responsibility for damages resulting from negligence or improper actions by Licensees occurring on the Property and arising out of Licensee's use of the Property.
- 6. Licensee shall indemnify and hold the County harmless from any and all claims, damages, losses, judgments, liabilities, expenses and other costs, including litigation costs and attorneys' fees, arising out of, resulting from, or in connection with the Licensee's occupation and use of the premises. The County shall assume liability for negligent acts and omissions committed by its employees, agents or contractors during the term of the License.
