#### **DISCUSSION:**

The Department of Environmental Resources Code Enforcement Unit responds to complaints throughout the unincorporated area of Stanislaus County and attempts to gain voluntary compliance through education and personal contact by working with property owners and those persons responsible for creating nuisances. Compliance efforts include issuing Administrative Citations, recording Notices of Non-Compliance with the Clerk-Recorders Office, presenting cases before the Nuisance Abatement Hearing Board and the Board of Supervisors, obtaining inspection warrants, and conducting forced clean ups.

On February 25, 2010, the Nuisance Abatement Hearing Board supported staff's recommendation to declare the property a nuisance and forwarded the matter to the Board of Supervisors recommending their approval. On March 16, 2010, the Board of Supervisors adopted the Hearing Board's Decision in Board Action No. 2010-128 and authorized a forced clean up at 1215 Imperial Avenue, Modesto. Following the Board's action, the Department of Environmental Resources obtained authorization from the Public Administrator's Office, whom are administering the property, and in conjunction with County Policy, contracted with Aaron's Hauling for the removal of the debris from the property.

On August 26, 2010, the Nuisance Abatement Hearing Board supported staff's recommendation that the billing for the cleanup of the property was reasonable and forwarded the matter to the Board of Supervisors for consideration. By adopting the Hearing Board's Decision of Costs, the Board of Supervisors affirms the reasonableness of the billing. Once adopted, the Department of Environmental Resources' Accounting Unit will bill the Public Administrator's Office. If payment is not received, the charges will be forwarded to the Treasurer/Tax Collector to be collected in a manner prescribed by County Code as a recorded lien by special assessment against the property. A detailed accounting of the billing is attached as Attachment AA.

#### **POLICY ISSUE:**

Approval of this agenda item to adopt the recommendations of the Nuisance Abatement Hearing Board regarding the Decision of Costs (Attachment 1) for 1215 Imperial Avenue, Modesto, is consistent with the Board's priorities of A Safe Community, A Healthy Community and the Efficient Delivery of Public Services. This approval will allow the Department to seek reimbursement for this abatement action and will support the Department's mission to promote a safe and healthy environment and improve the quality of life in the community through a balance of science, education, partnerships and environmental regulation.
