SUBJECT:

Approval of a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with the City of Modesto for the Annexation of the Jennings Road Wastewater Treatment Plant Facility

STAFF RECOMMENDATIONS:

- 1. Approve the Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) between the City of Modesto and Stanislaus County for the Annexation of the Jennings Road Wastewater Treatment Plant Facility.
- 2. Authorize the Chief Executive Officer to sign the Memorandum of Understanding between the City of Modesto and Stanislaus County for the Jennings Road Wastewater Treatment Plant Facility.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Following the annexation to the City of Modesto of the area of the Jennings Road Wastewater Treatment Plant Facility, the City will no longer be required to pay County property tax assessments. Based on 2009 tax figures, the property taxes for the property were \$101,000. The Memorandum of Understanding will require the City of Modesto to annex and maintain a 2.8 mile section of Jennings Road from North Main Street to the north property line of city-owned property near the Westport Drain Channel.

Approval of a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with the City of Modesto for the Annexation of the Jennings Road Wastewater Treatment Plant Facility

It is estimated that the road maintenance savings to Stanislaus County Public Works would be \$15,000 per mile for Jennings Road, or \$42,000 annually. County Public Works will continue to maintain the section of West Main Street that passes over the annexed area at a cost of approximately \$17,000 annually.

DISCUSSION:

The City of Modesto desires to annex 4,690 acres that include the wastewater treatment plant on Jennings Road. In discussions between staff from the City of Modesto and Stanislaus County areas of interest to both parties were identified. Staff from both agencies were involved in the preparation of the presented Memorandum of Understanding.

The Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) between the City of Modesto and Stanislaus County covers the following items:

City of Modesto:

- The City shall cooperate and participate in transportation studies for the South County Corridor. It is anticipated that the South County Corridor might traverse the Jennings Treatment Plant.
- The City shall grant the County an Irrevocable Offer of Dedication for 20-feet of right-of-way of West Main as it passes through the annexed area. This section of roadway is 1.77 miles in length. The existing right-of-way width of West Main east of Jennings Road is 90 feet. West Main is anticipated to be constructed as a four-lane Class "C" expressway with a right-of-way width of 110 feet. The Irrevocable Offer of Dedication will bring the right-of-way width of Main Street into conformance with Stanislaus County's General Plan Circulation Element.
- The City shall annex and maintain Jennings Road from West Main Street to the north property line of the city owned property near the Westport Drain Channel. Jennings Road will be maintained according to Stanislaus County Standards with City funds. The maintenance will be performed on a schedule similar to Stanislaus County road maintenance.
- All work completed in the West Main Street right-of-way for the installation of a future recycled water line, shall be placed in accordance with Stanislaus County Standards in place at the time the work is started.

Stanislaus County:

• The County shall provide advance notice of County road maintenance in the area of Jennings Road for the purpose of collaboration of effort to maintain Jennings Road at the lowest possible cost. Approval of a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) with the City of Modesto for the Annexation of the Jennings Road Wastewater Treatment Plant Facility

- West Main Street will remain part of the County right-of-way after the annexation. The County shall continue to be fully responsible for all work related to the operation, maintenance, repair, and improvements to the section of West Main Street that passes over the annexed area.
- Stanislaus County will allow the City access and use of the right-of-way along West Main Street including the bridge that crosses the San Joaquin River for installation of a future recycled water line. As part of the City's plan to deliver recycled wastewater from the Jennings Treatment Plant to farmers on the west side of the County, City Public Works staff anticipates the need for a water line crossing the San Joaquin River and extending westward. This section of the MOU allows the City to locate a future water line on the West Main Bridge spanning the San Joaquin River. For clarification, the County will not charge a fee for occupying space within right-of-way. The City will cover all construction, review and inspection fees and costs associated with a future water line.

The City Council approved the Memorandum of Understanding on August 3, 2010.

POLICY ISSUES:

This action is consistent with the Board's priorities of Effective Partnerships, Efficient Delivery of Public Services, and A Well Planned Infrastructure System by formalizing the agreement between Stanislaus County and the City of Modesto for the Annexation of the Jennings Road Wastewater Treatment Plant Facility.

STAFFING IMPACT:

Public Works staff has been involved in the formation of the contents of the Memorandum of Understanding with the City of Modesto over the annexation of the Jennings Road Wastewater Treatment Plant Facility.

MEMORANMUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN THE CITY OF MODESTO AND STANISLAUS COUNTY FOR THE JENNINGS TREATMENT PLANT

This Memorandum of Understanding is made and entered by and between the City of Modesto ("City"), and the County of Stanislaus ("County")" for the Jennings Treatment Plant, on <u>August 4</u>, 2010.

WHEREAS, Jennings Road is a collector street, extending between Service Road and West Main Street, currently located entirely in the unincorporated area of Stanislaus County, operated and maintained by the County Public Works; and

WHEREAS, the City of Modesto desires to annex to the City the unincorporated area that includes the Jennings Treatment Plant; and

WHEREAS, the City of Modesto is the owner of approximately 4,793 acres of real property on which the City's Jennings Treatment Plant was constructed, located approximately seven miles southwest of the Modesto City limits on the south side of Keyes Road, West of Vivian Road; and

WHEREAS, a portion of the Jennings Treatment Plant totaling 102.7 acres was annexed into the City on December 30, 1969; and

WHEREAS, the City of Modesto has submitted a written request to initiate annexation of the remainder of the Jennings Treatment Plant, 15 parcels totaling 4,690 acres, to the City of Modesto under the Cortese-Knox-Hertzberg Local Reorganization Act of 2000, California Government Code Section 56000, et seq; and

WHEREAS, California Government Code section 56742 allows the annexation of noncontiguous territory which is used by a city for the reclamation, disposal and storage of treated wastewater; and

WHEREAS Government Code section 56428 authorizes any person or local agency to file a written request with the Executive Officer of its Local Agency Formation Commission ("LAFCO") to amend a sphere of influence; and

WHEREAS, the request to amend the City of Modesto's sphere of influence and the Resolution of Application are proposed pursuant to California Government Code Sections 56428, 56650, 56654 and 56700; and

WHEREAS, Government Code Section 56650 provides that proceedings to initiate a change of organization to annex additional territory to a City may be initiated by Resolution of Application or Petition; and WHEREAS, the Property proposed to be annexed is uninhabited, and a description of the boundaries of the subject Property is set forth in Exhibits "A" and "B", attached hereto and by this reference incorporated herein; and

WHEREAS, the Property is covered by the Master Property Tax Agreement entered into between the County of Stanislaus and the nine cities in its jurisdiction, which was approved by the County Board on February 27, 1996; and

WHEREAS, the proposed Property is not subject to a Williamson Act Agreement, and

WHEREAS, the proposed annexation abuts or surrounds sections of Jennings Road, West Main Street and

WHEREAS, the Stanislaus County and City of Modesto staffs recognize that it would be mutually beneficial if a single agency operated and maintained the entire length of Jennings Road; and

WHEREAS, the Stanislaus County envisions a future South County Corridor which might traverse the City of Modesto Jennings Treatment Plant; and

NOW THEREFORE, the County and City mutually agree as follows:

CITY OBLIGATIONS

- 1. The City shall cooperate and participate in transportation studies for the South County Corridor.
- 2. The City shall grant the County an irrevocable deed of land to expand the width West Main Street right-of-way to 110 feet to accommodated future widening to County Standard for a four lane road. The Current recorded right-of-way is 90 feet, so the City will provide ten (10) additional feet on each side of West Man Street as it passes through the annexed area.
- 3. The City shall maintain, according to Stanislaus County Standards, the section of Jennings Road north of West Main Street to the north property line of city owned property near Westport Drain channel. Maintenance shall be performed on a schedule similar to Stanislaus County road maintenance. This road maintenance will be accomplished with City of Modesto funds.
- 4. All work completed in the West Main Street right-of-way for the installation of a future recycled water line, shall be done in accordance with County Standards in place at the time the work is commenced.

COUNTY OBLIGATIONS

- 1. The County shall provide advance notice of County road maintenance in the area of Jennings Road for the purpose of collaboration of effort to maintain Jennings Road at the lowest possible cost.
- 2. The County shall continue to be fully responsible for all work related to operation, maintenance, repair, and improvements to the section of West Main Street that passes over the annexed area. This work will be accomplished with County funds.
- 3. At no cost to the City, the County will allow the City access and use of the right-ofway along West Main Street including the bridge that crosses the San Joaquin River for installation of a future recycled water line.

MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS

- 1. <u>Additional Documents</u>: Each party shall, at the request of the other, acknowledge and deliver whatever additional instruments and do such other acts as may be reasonably necessary to carry out the intent and purpose of this Agreement.
- 2. <u>Entire Agreement</u>: This Agreement is the entire agreement of the parties. There are no understandings or agreements pertaining to this Agreement except as are expressly stated in writing in this Agreement or in any document attached hereto or incorporated herein by reference.
- 3. <u>Amendment</u>: Any amendment of this Agreement shall be in writing, signed by both parties hereto.
- 4. <u>Negotiated Agreement</u>: This Agreement has been arrived at through negotiation between the parties. Neither party is to be deemed the party that prepared this Agreement within the meaning of California Civil Code Section 1654.
- 5. <u>Indemnity</u>: Neither party, nor any of its officers or employees, shall be responsible for any damage or liability occurring by reason of anything done or omitted to be done by the other party under or in connection with any work delegated to that party under this Agreement. The parties further agree, pursuant to Government Code section 895.4, that each party shall fully indemnify and hold harmless the other party and its agents, officers, employees and contractors from and against all claims, damages, losses, judgments, liabilities, expenses and other costs, including litigation costs and attorney fees, arising out of, resulting from, or in connection with any work delegated to or action taken or omitted to be taken by such party under this Agreement.

6. <u>Notices</u>: Any notices required herein shall be in writing and be given personally or by certified mail, return receipt requested, addressed to the respective parties as follows:

JENNINGS ROAD ANNEXATION LEGAL DESCRIPTION

All that certain property situate, lying, and being portions of Sections 14, 15, 22 and 23, Township 5 South, Range 8 East, Mount Diablo Base and Meridian, lying in the County of Stanislaus, State of California, and being more particularly described as follows:


