## PROCLAIMING JUNE 2011 AS DISABILITY AWERENESS MONTH IN STANISLAUS COUNTY

WHEREAS, the Stanislaus County Board of Supervisors has recognized healthy communities as a priority; and,

WHEREAS, Disability Awareness is important for every person's well being as well as that of our families, communities and businesses; and,

WHEREAS, disabilities can affect all people, regardless of race, age, gender or social status; and, There are an estimated 4,268,000 people with disabilities in the state of California, or 13.1% of the population over the age of five.

WHEREAS, within the next year, at least one out of eight Californians will experience a disability personally or through a family member; and,

WHEREAS, Around 2,350,000 Californians have a form of work disability, while 856,000 people with disabilities in the state are employed. Approximately 136,000 people with disabilities in the state of California are unemployed, and 1,302,000 are currently not in the workforce.

WHEREAS, over 36 million Americans are classified as disabled; about 12% of the total population. More than 50% of those disabled Americans are in their working years, from 18-64

WHEREAS, increasing public awareness about person's with disabilities is vital to fighting the stigma and discrimination that often serve as a barrier to employment; and,

WHEREAS, People with disabilities enjoy life, feel good about themselves, are able to meet challenges and changes of life; and,

WHEREAS, The Society (for children and adults with disabilities,) commemorating June 2011 and each June thereafter as Disability Awareness Month.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Stanislaus County Board of Supervisors does hereby unanimously proclaim June 2011 as Disability Awareness Month in Stanislaus County and commends this observance to all our residents.
