Approval to Adopt the Recommended Decision of the Nuisance Abatement Hearing Board Regarding the Cost Accounting to Abate the Nuisance at 6155 Foote Road, Ceres, California and Barnhart Road, Ceres, California, case number 782009-ABT

DISCUSSION:

The Agricultural Commissioner's Office responds to abandon orchard complaints throughout Stanislaus County and attempts to gain voluntary compliance through education and personal contact by working with the property owners and those persons responsible for creating nuisances. Compliance efforts include providing technical advice on eliminating or managing pests and issuing warning letters and notices of violations. The Agricultural Commissioner also consults with other agencies in an effort to settle complaints. When these measures are not successful, the Department will present the case before the Nuisance Abatement Hearing Board and the Board of Supervisors. The subject case is the first time that the Agricultural Commissioner has had to take a nuisance property through the formal process for resolution.

On March 25, 2010, the Nuisance Abatement Hearing Board supported staff's recommendation to declare the property a nuisance and forwarded the matter to the Board of Supervisors recommending their approval. On April 20, 2010, the Board of Supervisors adopted the Hearing Board's Decision in Board Action No. 2010-202 and authorized a forced clean up at 6155 Foote Road, Ceres and Barnhart Road, Ceres. Following the Board's action, the Agricultural Commissioner's Office obtained an abatement and inspection warrant, and consistent with County policy, contracted with Valley Uprooting, LLC for the removal of stumps and brush and with Animal Damage Management for ground squirrel control.

On April 28, 2011, the Nuisance Abatement Hearing Board supported staff's recommendation that the billing for the clean up of the property was reasonable and forwarded the matter to the Board of Supervisors for consideration. By adopting the Hearing Board's Decision of Costs, the Board of Supervisors affirms the reasonableness of the billing. Once adopted, the Agricultural Commissioner's Accounting Unit will bill the property owner. If payment is not received, the charges will be forwarded to the Treasurer/Tax Collector to be collected in a manner prescribed by County Code as a recorded lien by special assessment against the property. A detailed accounting of the billing is attached as Attachment AA.

POLICY ISSUE:

The Board should decide if it should accept, modify, or reject the written decision as presented in the Decision of Costs 782009-ABT (Attachment 1). Acceptance of staff's recommendation would be consistent with the Board's priorities of a Strong Agricultural Economy/Heritage and the Efficient Delivery of Public Services and is aligned with the Department's mission to support and protect the well-being of of agriculture, business and the community.
