Approval to Adopt the Recommended Decision of the Nuisance Abatement Hearing Board Regarding the Cost Accounting to Abate the Nuisance at 1209 Sam Avenue, Modesto, California, Case Number CE 10-0366

DISCUSSION:

The Department of Environmental Resources responds to complaints throughout the unincorporated area of Stanislaus County and attempts to gain voluntary compliance through education and personal contact by working with the property owners and those persons responsible for creating nuisances. Compliance efforts include issuing Administrative Citations, recording Notices of Non-Compliance with the Clerk-Recorders Office, presenting cases before the Nuisance Abatement Hearing Board and the Board of Supervisors, obtaining inspection warrants, and conducting forced clean ups.

On October 28, 2010, the Nuisance Abatement Hearing Board supported staff's recommendation to declare the property a nuisance and forwarded the matter to the Board of Supervisors recommending their approval. On November 30, 2010, the Board of Supervisors adopted the Hearing Board's Decision in Board Action No. 2010-710 and authorized a forced clean up at 1209 Sam Avenue, Modesto. Following the Board's action, the Department of Environmental Resources obtained an abatement and inspection warrant, and in conjunction with County Policy, contracted with Affordable Hauling for the removal of the debris and the securing of the dwelling on the property.

On July 28, 2011, the Nuisance Abatement Hearing Board supported staff's recommendation that the billing for the clean up of the property was reasonable and forwarded the matter to the Board of Supervisors for consideration. By adopting the Hearing Board's Decision of Costs, the Board of Supervisors affirms the reasonableness of the billing. Once adopted, the Department of Environmental Resources' Accounting Unit will bill the property owner. If payment is not received, the charges will be forwarded to the Treasurer/Tax Collector to be collected in a manner prescribed by County Code as a recorded lien by special assessment against the property. A detailed accounting of the billing is attached as Attachment AA.

POLICY ISSUE:

Approval of this agenda item to adopt the recommendations of the Nuisance Abatement Hearing Board regarding the Decision of Costs (Attachment 1) for 1209 Sam Avenue, Modesto, is consistent with the Board's priorities of A Safe Community, A Healthy Community, and the Efficient Delivery of Public Services. This approval will allow the Department to seek reimbursement for this abatement action and will support the Department's mission to promote a safe and healthy environment and improve the quality of life in the community through a balance of science, education, partnerships, and environmental regulation.
