Approval to Adopt a Resolution Certifying the Stanislaus County Maintained Road System Mileage

STAFF RECOMMENDATIONS:

Adopt a resolution certifying the mileage in Stanislaus County's maintained mileage road system to be 1521.18 miles as of December 31, 2011.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Maintained mileage is one of the components used in the distribution of Highway Users Tax Account (HUTA) funds. HUTA funds are allocated proportionally to agencies based upon the jurisdiction's reported maintained mileage and number of registered vehicles. HUTA funds are used for the general maintenance of county roadways.

## Approval to Adopt a Resolution Certifying the Stanislaus County Maintained Road System Mileage

### **DISCUSSION:**

Section 2121 of the California Streets and Highways (S&H) Code confers upon the Board of Supervisors the authority, duties, and limitations that have to do with the establishment and maintenance of the county road system. All agencies are required to submit an annual Maintained Mileage Report to the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans). The previous maintained mileage report was adopted by the Board of Supervisors on April 5, 2011.

The main objective of this activity is to supply the necessary information for distribution of HUTA funds in accordance with Section 2104 of the S&H Code.

The total maintained mileage as of December 31, 2011 is 1521.18 miles. This is a net decrease of 3.27 miles from the previously reported mileage of 1524.45 miles as of December 31, 2010. This net decrease is due to various annexations as seen in the attached table summary (Exhibit A).

### **POLICY ISSUES:**

Approval of the maintained mileage is an integral part of Public Works' funding for road maintenance and repair through HUTA fund allocation and supports the Board's priority of A Well Planned Infrastructure System.

**A RESOLUTION CERTIFYING THE MILEAGE IN STANISLAUS COUNTY'S MAINTAINED ROAD  
SYSTEM TO BE 1521.18 MILES AS OF DECEMBER 31, 2011**

Whereas, Section 2121 of the California Streets and Highway Code provides that each year counties shall submit to the California Department of Transportation the additions to and deletions from their total mileage of maintained county roads; and

Whereas, the California Department of Transportation certified to the State Controller that the total mileage of maintained County roads in the Stanislaus County, as of December 31, 2010, was 1524.45 miles; and

Whereas, the Director of Public Works has reported that as of December 31, 2011, there was a net decrease of 3.27 miles to the total mileage of maintained County roads during 2011; and

Whereas, the Director of Public Works has also reported that as of December 31, 2011, the total mileage of maintained County roads is 1521.18 miles.

Now, therefore, it is hereby determined and ordered based on the information provided by the Director of Public Works, that this Board certifies the County maintained mileage attached hereto and made a part hereof, that the mileage of County maintained roads as of December 31, 2011 is certified to be 1521.18 miles.
