Ordinance C.S. 1115 amends the existing Fink Road Landfill fees to eliminate the stand-alone fee categories for small dead animals and adds new fees which include the following: a) charging a separate handling fee for specified appliances and mattresses: b) charging a fee for loader-sized tires; c) charging a fee for loader-sized tires; c) charging a fee for dead horses; and d) offering a discounted waste-to-energy tipping fee during diversions for in-county jurisdictions (only) that have a Disposal Agreement with the County. Lastly, modifications to existing fees include increasing the "Price by Load" for passenger cars/station-wagons/SUVs/mini-vans, the ash tipping fee, small dead animal fees, and the fees for various tire sizes.
