DISCUSSION:

Behavioral Health and Recovery Services (BHRS) is requesting authorization to pay three invoices that are over one year old. The Department has recently received these invoices from two vendors, the Stanislaus County Office of Education and Panoramic Software. All invoices indicate that they have previously been sent to BHRS. The Department's General Services office has experienced significant staff turnover and shortages over the past two years, including the untimely deaths of two staff. Whether these invoices were received in a timely manner can not be determined.

The service dates range between February 2011 and June 2011, and are a combined total of \$6,771.36. Those for the Office of Education are for printing of various BHRS programs and total \$276.36. The Panoramic Software invoices are for software support for the Rep-Payee Pro System, used by the Public Guardian and the Sheriff's Office Public Administrator. The Sheriff's Office will reimburse BHRS for a portion of this cost.

POLICY ISSUE:

Approval of this agenda item will meet the Board's priority of Efficient Delivery of Public Services by providing economic support to area vendors.
