Approval to Adopt the Mitigated Negative Declaration and Adopt Plans and Specifications for the SR 99/SR 219 (Kiernan Avenue) Interchange Project and Set Bid Opening Date

STAFF RECOMMENDATIONS (continued):

- 4. Acting as a responsible agency for the proposed project, adopt the Mitigated Negative Declaration pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Section 15074(B), by finding on the basis of the whole record, including the Initial Study and any comments received, that there is no substantial evidence the project will have a significant effect on the environment and that the Mitigated Negative Declaration reflects Stanislaus County's independent judgment and analysis.
- 5. Direct the Department of Public Works to file a Notice of Determination in accordance with Section 21152(a) of the California Public Resources Code.

DISCUSSION:

Stanislaus County, in cooperation with Caltrans District 10, proposes to reconstruct the SR 99/SR 219 (Kiernan Avenue) Interchange in the community of Salida. This project will help facilitate future growth, help alleviate traffic congestion, and will improve the operation of this interchange. Increasing the efficiency of the interchange will also encourage the free flow of goods and services for the region and the State. Two build alternatives and the no-build alternative were proposed and studied for this interchange. Alternative #1 was the preferred alternative and has been estimated to cost approximately \$46.5 million (in today's dollars) for environmental, design, right-of-way acquisitions, utility relocations, and construction. The environmental, design, right-of-way phase, and utility relocations is funded by the Stanislaus County Public Facilities Fees and environmental mitigation fees. The SR 99 Bond Savings funds (\$37 million) will cover 100% the construction phase of the project.

The proposed interchange improvements include reconstruction of the existing interchange to provide improved operations for turning movements to and from State Route (SR) 99, as well as associated local road improvements at adjacent intersections.

California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) and National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) clearance was obtained on May 25, 2011 by Caltrans. An Initial Study with Mitigated Negative Declaration/Environmental Assessment with Finding of No Significant Impact was prepared, circulated, approved, and adopted by Caltrans.

The County of Stanislaus is acting as a responsible agency for the proposed project. Caltrans acting as lead agency prepared an Initial Study, consulted with the County of Stanislaus, and adopted a Mitigated Negative Declaration for this project on May 25, 2011. There are no significant environmental impacts of the proposed project. Upon your Board's finding that the project will not have a significant effect on the environment, Public Works will file a Notice of Determination in accordance with Section 21152(a) of the California Public Resources Code.

Approval to Adopt the Mitigated Negative Declaration and Adopt Plans and Specifications for the SR 99/SR 219 (Kiernan Avenue) Interchange Project and Set Bid Opening Date

The design phase of the project, including right of way certification, was completed on May 14, 2012 and is now ready for advertisement, bidding, and contract award. To assure project funding using Proposition 1B-State Route 99 Savings money, it is imperative to have the project advertised and awarded by the end of the 2012 calendar year. Public Works staff recommends that the Board of Supervisors adopt the plans and specifications and set the bid opening date.

POLICY ISSUES:

The recommended actions are consistent with the Board's priorities of providing A Safe Community, A Healthy Community and A Well Planned Infrastructure System by providing a reconstructed interchange of Kiernan Avenue that will be functionally operational and safe for the traveling public.
