Approval to Summarily Vacate a Portion of Undeveloped Sherry Lane Located North of Stewart Road and West of McHenry Avenue

DISCUSSION:

This item is regarding the abandonment of a portion of unimproved Sherry Lane in the unincorporated neighborhood of Del Rio. This portion of road is bordered on the north and west sides by property owned by the applicant, Ms. Leta S. Love. Sherry Lane intersects Stewart Road between McHenry Avenue and St John Road. This portion of road has not been developed or maintained for road purposes by the County. Public Works has an easement for road way purposes, but has determined that this portion of Sherry Lane is excess right-of-way and is not needed for future road purposes. This abandonment is being pursued because the owner wants to improve the roadside by having curb and gutter installed that would be consistent with the adjacent property to the east. This summary abandonment will allow Ms. Love the ability to complete the site improvements.

The utility companies, AT&T, PG&E, and Modesto Irrigation District have facilities within the abandonment area. A Public Utility Easement will be retained at the existing location to protect their interests.

POLICY ISSUES:

The recommended actions support the Board's priorities of A Safe Community and A Well Planned Infrastructure System by removing any excess right-of-way that is not needed for road way purposes, therefore removing any liability. Street and Highways Code 8334(a) states that the legislative body of a local agency may summarily vacate excess right-of-way of a street or highway not required for street or highway purposes.

STAFFING IMPACT:

There is no staffing impact associated with this item.

TO SUMMARILY VACATE A PORTION OF UNDEVELOPED SHERRY LANE LOCATED NORTH OF STEWART ROAD AND WEST OF MCHENRY AVENUE

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of Supervisors, of the County of Stanislaus, State of California, hereby finds and determines as follows:

- 1. The vacation of a portion of undeveloped Sherry Road described herein below is made under Chapter 4, Part 3, of Division 9 of the California Street and Highway Code (Section 8334 (a & b)).
- 2. The undeveloped portion of Sherry Lane to be vacated is not required for street or highway purposes, and is more particularly described in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and shown on the precise map attached hereto as Exhibit "B".
- 3. The portion of Sherry Lane to be vacated hereby is not required for street or highway purposes.
- 4. The road reservation to be vacated is to be maintained as a Public Utility Easement. Pursuant to the provisions of Section 8340 Street and Highway Code.
- 5. That from and after the date this resolution is recorded by Stanislaus County, the vacated portion of Sherry Lane herein described no longer constitutes part of a street or highway.
- A certified copy of this Resolution shall be provided to the Department of Public Works for recordation.

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
