The Keyes Community Services District may determine, in writing, that a particular consultant, although a "designated position," is hired to perform a range of duties that are limited in scope and, thus, is not required to fully comply with the disclosure requirements described in this section. Such written determination shall include a decryption of the consultant's duties and, based upon the description, a statement of the extent of disclosure requirements. Such determination shall be a public record and shall be retained for public inspection in the same manner and location as this Conflict of Interest Code.
