Approval to Introduce and Waive the First Reading of an Ordinance Amending Provisions of Stanislaus County Code Title 2, Chapter 40, Park Commission

DISCUSSION:

The Park Commission is an advisory board comprised of seven members; one resident from each of the five Supervisorial districts of Stanislaus County, and two members to represent the County at large. At the December 15, 2011 Park Commission meeting, the Commission discussed the need to review their bylaws, Title 2, Chapter 40, Park Commission, with special attention to section 2.40.060, Quorum. The current section states, "Four members shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business by the Park Commission, but a lesser number may adjourn from time to time." The Commission suggested changing this section to accommodate uninterrupted transactions of business should three or more vacancies occur. A request was made to add this topic as an action item on the January 2012 Park Commission meeting agenda.

On January 12, 2012, the Park Commission voted unanimously to recommend changes to Title 2, Chapter 40, of the Park Commission bylaws. Specifically, the Commission discussed the following changes to be made throughout the bylaws: 1) change applicable language where necessary to gender-neutral terms, specifically, 'chairman' to 'chairperson' and 'his' and 'her' to 'his/her', this would impact sections 2.40.040 Officer election, 2.40.050 Meetings, and 2.40.090 Vacancy because of absence; 2) under section 2.40.040 Officer election, include an election of a vice-chairperson; and 3) change section 2.40.060 Quorum, to read, "The majority of appointed Park Commissioners shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business by the Park Commission, but a lesser number may adjourn from time to time."

These recommendations were brought forward to County Counsel for review in March and again for final review in October 2012. With Counsel's concurrence, the Department of Parks and Recreation is bringing this forward to the Board to amend Title 2, Chapter 40, Park Commission as follows:

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND SECTIONS OF THE STANISLAUS COUNTY CODE

THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF STANISLAUS, STATE OF CALIFORNIA, DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Sections 2.40.040, 2.40.050, 2.40.060, and 2.40.090 of the Stanislaus County Code are hereby amended as follows:

2.40.040 Officer Election.

"The park commission shall organize by electing one of its members chairperson and one member vice-chairperson. It shall also elect a secretary, who need not be a member. The officers of the park commission shall be elected on the last regular meeting of each calendar year for a term of one year."

2.40.050 Meetings.

"The park commission shall establish a time and place for regular meetings which shall be held at least once every two months. Special meetings maybe held upon the call of the chairperson."

2.40.060 Quorum.

"The majority of appointed park commissioners shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business by the park commission, but a lesser number may convene from time to time. In the event that two member vacancies on the park commission exist simultaneously, then a quorum shall consist of a majority of the currently serving members."

2.40.090 Vacancy because of absence.

"After a member of the park commission fails to attend three consecutive meetings, unless excused by the majority vote of the commission, his/her membership thereon shall be automatically terminated and a successor shall be appointed by the board of supervisors to serve for the unexpired portion of the term."

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect 30 days from and after the date of its passage and before the expiration of 15 days after its passage it shall be published once, with the names of the members voting for and against the same, in the Modesto Bee, a newspaper published in the County of Stanislaus, State of California.
