Mr. Langman is an active and respected member of the Mental Health Board. He is the past Chair of the Older Adult System of Care Committee, the current Chair of the Administrative and Fiscal Management Committee, and also serves on the Board's Executive Committee. He has been active in many Board initiatives, including the presentation of the Mental Health Board's Annual Report to the Board of Supervisors.
