SUBJECT:

Approval of an Amendment to an Agreement with California Psychiatric Transitions, Inc. for Mental Health Services for Fiscal Year 2012-2013

STAFF RECOMMENDATIONS:

1. Approve the amendment to an agreement with California Psychiatric Transitions, Inc. to provide care for adults with serious mental illness in need of an institution for mental disease through the end of Fiscal Year 2012-2013.
2. Authorize the Behavioral Health Director, or her designee, to sign the amendment with California Psychiatric Transitions, Inc.

FISCAL IMPACT:

The Board approved budget for Fiscal Year 2012-2013 for Behavioral Health and Recovery Services included funding in the amount of \$133,500 for the agreement with California Psychiatric Transitions, Inc. The budget has available appropriations to fund the additional \$268,600 requested through this amendment. If the amendment is approved by the Board, the cumulative total of this agreement from July 1, 2010 to June 30, 2013 would be \$535,600. There is no impact to the County General Fund.

DISCUSSION:

Behavioral Health and Recovery Services is experiencing an increased demand to place severely mentally ill adults in treatment facilities. On May 22, 2012, the Board of Supervisors approved an agreement with California Psychiatric Transitions, Inc. to provide care for Behavioral Health and Recovery Services clients with serious mental illness in need of an institution for mental disease (Board Order No. 2012-237). California Psychiatric Transitions, Inc. has agreed to provide 799 additional bed days to accommodate the increased need. Behavioral Health and Recovery Services requests approval to amend the current agreement with California Psychiatric Transitions, Inc. by increasing the contract maximum in the current fiscal year by \$268,600. The contract maximum for Fiscal Year 2012-2013 would increase to \$402,100 from the original amount of \$133,500. This would increase the number of bed days from 301 to 1,100 and increase the number of days of enhanced services from 60 to 150.

Behavioral Health and Recovery Services experiences occasional funding opportunities and unanticipated increases in the utilization of services throughout the year. On many occasions, this additional funding is time sensitive; hence, the Board of Supervisors previously provided authorization for the Behavioral Health Director, or her designee, to negotiate and execute amendments up to \$75,000 to this agreement, budget permitting, without further action by the Board, throughout Fiscal Year 2012-2013.

As required by the Board of Supervisors, the following table includes a cumulative value of prior contracts with this vendor for the period of July 1, 2010 through June 30, 2013.

**AMENDMENT
TO INDEPENDENT AGREEMENT**

This Amendment is made and entered into in the City of Modesto, State of California, by and between the County of Stanislaus (hereinafter referred to as "County"), and California Psychiatric Transitions, a California Corporation (hereinafter referred to as "Contractor"), for and in consideration of the premises, and the mutual promises, covenants, terms, and conditions hereinafter contained.

WHEREAS, County and Contractor entered into an agreement dated July 1, 2012 to provide care for adults with serious mental illness in need of an institution for mental diseased clients; and

WHEREAS, County has experienced an increased need and Contractor has agreed to provide additional bed days and enhanced services; and

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of mutual promises, covenants, terms, and conditions hereinafter contained, the Agreement, which was entered into on July 1, 2012, is amended to increase the contract maximum amount by \$268,600, from \$133,500 to \$402,100, increasing by 799 additional bed days from 301 to 1100 bed days and increasing enhanced services by approximately 90 days from 60 days to 150 days of Enhanced Services. This amendment is incorporated into the Agreement as follows:

- I. Exhibit A, Section D Compensation, Item 4 is deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:
 - 4. The parties hereto acknowledge the maximum amount to be paid by the County for services provided shall not exceed \$402,100 for the term of this agreement. This amount is estimated based on approximately 1,100 bed days and approximately 150 days of Enhanced Services.
- II. County agrees that Contractor shall have the right to add to the billing any amount owed to Contractor by County as a result of services rendered by Contractor and accepted by County prior to the execution of this Amendment to California Psychiatric Transitions Agreement. If Contractor exercises the right to add to the billing, Contractor shall give County notice of the amount and an itemization of the billing.
- III. All other terms and conditions of said Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.
