#### **DISCUSSION:**

In 2007, Stanislaus County amended and adopted changes to the Agricultural Element that included policy language directing Staff to undertake a review and update of the element every five years. The intent of which was to conduct a periodic evaluation of the goals, objectives, policies, and implementation measures of the document to ensure that the language remains relevant to the needs of local agriculture. This amendment is the result of an update process initiated in 2011/2012. The proposed amendment focuses on specific areas that include: food safety, alternative energy sources, agricultural land mitigation, use of tertiary water, and ground water protection.

On March 21, 2013, the Stanislaus County Planning Commission held a public hearing to review the Draft Agricultural Element, heard as General Plan Amendment No. PLN2012-044. There was extensive discussion amongst the Commissioners related to the proposed amended agriculture land mitigation language that, if approved, will provide for a "minimum" 1:1 ratio of agricultural land that is converted for a residential land use.

Due to a lack of a majority vote, the Planning Commission's ultimate recommendation to the Board of Supervisors is to deny the proposed amendment. Initially, the Planning Commission made a motion to recommend approval (Etchebarne/Peterson) to the Board but this motion failed on a 3-3 vote to achieve a required majority. A second motion was made to recommend a denial (Buehner/Crabtree) but again on a 3-3 vote, this motion failed due to not achieving a required majority. A final motion to recommend approval, except for the addition of the word "minimum" to the 1:1 Agricultural Land Mitigation, was made (Crabtree/No second) and due to no commissioner seconding the motion, the motion failed.

It is important to note that the 1:1 Agricultural Land Mitigation requirement was originally introduced in the 2007 Agricultural Element update and was established to address the conversion or "loss" of agricultural land due to a discretionary project that proposed an amendment to the General Plan designation (of the subject property) from "Agriculture" to a designation allowing a residential land use. As part of the current Agricultural Element Update, the proposed changes to the Agricultural Land Mitigation are to include the word "minimum" to the 1:1 ratio in order to identify that any mitigation will require a standard that is at least at a 1:1 ratio, but not lower than a 1:1 replacement ratio.

At this time, this item simply sets the date and time for a public hearing on the matter before the Board of Supervisors to consider the proposed request.

#### **POLICY ISSUES:**

The Board of Supervisors should determine if setting a public hearing for the proposed amendment furthers the goals of the Efficient Delivery of Public Services.
