Approval of Amendments to Agreements with California Psychiatric Transitions, Inc. and the Center for Human Services for Additional Mental Health and Alcohol and Other Drug Services for Fiscal Year 2012-2013
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DISCUSSION:

Behavioral Health and Recovery Services (BHRS) is experiencing an increased demand to place adults with a serious mental illness in treatment facilities. On May 22, 2012, the Board of Supervisors approved an agreement with California Psychiatric Transitions, Inc. to provide care for BHRS clients with a serious mental illness in need of an Institution for Mental Disease (Board Order No. 2012-237). On December 4, 2012, the Board of Supervisors approved an amendment to the agreement with California Psychiatric Transitions, Inc. to provide 799 additional bed days to accommodate the increased need. The amendment increased the agreement with California Psychiatric Transitions, Inc. by \$268,600, from the original contract maximum of \$267,000 to \$535,600. Behavioral Health and Recovery Services requests approval for a second amendment to the agreement with California Psychiatric Transitions, Inc. to increase the contract maximum in Fiscal Year 2012-2013 by an additional \$137,900 (from \$535,600 to \$673,500). This would increase the number of bed days by another 650 (from 1,100 to 1,750) and increase the number of days of enhanced services by 100 (from 150 to 250).

On June 19, 2012, the Board of Supervisors approved an agreement with the Center for Human Services to provide high quality community located Alcohol and Other Drug (AOD) Intensive Outpatient Program (IOP) services for men and women who reside in Stanislaus County and meet the guidelines and eligibility to receive these federally funded services. Behavioral Health and Recovery Services requests approval of an amendment to the agreement with the Center for Human Services to increase the Alcohol and Other Drug, Intensive Outpatient Program services in order to expand the services delivered in all areas and to add an additional area of service in the community. The original agreement was to provide services in Modesto and Patterson. The amendment expands the services provided in Modesto and Patterson and adds services in West Modesto, by adding \$150,000 to the original contract amount of \$150,000, bringing the contract maximum for the Fiscal Year 2012-2013 to \$300,000.

As required by the Board of Supervisors, the following table includes a cumulative value of prior contracts with this vendor for the period of July 1, 2010 through June 30, 2013.

AMENDMENT TO PROVIDER AGREEMENT

This Amendment is made and entered into in the City of Modesto, State of California, by and between the County of Stanislaus (hereinafter referred to as "COUNTY"), and Center for Human Services, a California Non-profit Corporation (hereinafter referred to as "CONTRACTOR"), effective the date of the last signature, for and in consideration of the premises, and the mutual promises, covenants, terms, and conditions hereinafter contained.

WHEREAS, as a result of RFP 11-44-SS, COUNTY and CONTRACTOR entered into an agreement dated July 1, 2012 to provide high quality community located Alcohol and Other Drug (AOD) Intensive Outpatient Program (IOP) Services for men and women who reside in Stanislaus County and who meet the guidelines and eligibility to receive these federally funded services; and

WHEREAS, COUNTY has requested and CONTRACTOR has agreed to increase the consecutive number of AOD IOP's provided to expand services to more areas in the community; and

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of mutual promises, covenants, terms, and conditions hereinafter contained, the Agreement, which was entered into on July 1, 2012, is amended to increase the minimum number of programs to seven (7) and to increase the contract maximum amount by \$150,000, from \$150,000 to \$300,000 for these additional services. This amendment is incorporated into the Agreement as follows:

- I. Exhibit A, Item 1 Services, Paragraph 1.1 is revised to increase the number of consecutive AOD IOP's provided, as follows:
 - 1.1 CONTRACTOR shall provide a minimum of seven (7) consecutive Intensive Outpatient Group Services, defined as AOD Groups, to be held in Modesto, West Modesto and Patterson. These groups shall be for three (3) hours in duration, three (3) times per week, for approximately three (3) months (but may be up to six months) per client. This translates to thirty-six (36) group sessions over approximately three (3) months, including, at a minimum, one individual session each at admission and discharge and for each Treatment Planning session that exceeds the 90 day period. This includes urinallysis testing, to be administered at a minimum of one time per month, or more as needed for cause.
- II. Exhibit A, Item 3 Billing and Payment, Paragraph 3.2 is revised to increase the contract maximum amount, as follows:
 - 3.2 In consideration of CONTRACTOR's provision of services required under this Agreement, COUNTY shall reimburse CONTRACTOR at an amount not to exceed the Contract Maximum of \$300,000 for salaries, benefits and other operating costs.
- III. Exhibit A, Item 3 Billing and Payment, Paragraph 3.3 is added as follows:
 - 3.3 CONTRACTOR shall invoice COUNTY monthly for the services delivered under the terms of this Agreement. COUNTY shall make payment to CONTRACTOR for any undisputed invoice amounts within thirty (30) days of invoice receipt.

IV. All other terms and conditions of said Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.

SECOND AMENDMENT TO INDEPENDENT AGREEMENT

This Amendment is made and entered into in the City of Modesto, State of California, by and between the County of Stanislaus (hereinafter referred to as "County"), and California Psychiatric Transitions, a California Corporation (hereinafter referred to as "Contractor"), for and in consideration of the premises, and the mutual promises, covenants, terms, and conditions hereinafter contained. This Agreement is effective the date of the last signature.

WHEREAS, County and Contractor entered into an agreement dated July 1, 2012 to provide care for adults with serious mental illness in need of an institution for mental diseased clients; and

WHEREAS, County has experienced an increased need and Contractor has agreed to provide additional bed days and enhanced services; and

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of mutual promises, covenants, terms, and conditions hereinafter contained, the Agreement, which was entered into on July 1, 2012, is amended to increase the contract maximum amount by \$137,900, from \$402,100 to \$540,000, increasing by 650 additional bed days from 1100 to 1750 bed days and increasing enhanced services by approximately 100 days from 150 days to 250 days of Enhanced Services. This amendment is incorporated into the Agreement as follows:

- I. Exhibit A, Section D Compensation, Item 4 is deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:
 - 4. The parties hereto acknowledge the maximum amount to be paid by the County for services provided shall not exceed \$540,000 for the term of this agreement. This amount is estimated based on approximately 1,750 bed days and approximately 250 days of Enhanced Services.
- II. County agrees that Contractor shall have the right to add to the billing any amount owed to Contractor by County as a result of services rendered by Contractor and accepted by County prior to the execution of this Amendment to California Psychiatric Transitions Agreement. If Contractor exercises the right to add to the billing, Contractor shall give County notice of the amount and an itemization of the billing.
- III. All other terms and conditions of said Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.
