**NOTICE OF PETITIONS FOR TEMPORARY CHANGE INVOLVING THE TRANSFER OF 20,000 ACRE-FEET OF WATER TO WESTLANDS WATER DISTRICT UNDER PLACER COUNTY WATER AGENCY'S PERMITS 13856 AND 13858 (APPLICATIONS 18085 AND 18087)**

On April 23, 2013, Placer County Water Agency (PCWA) filed two petitions for change with the State Water Board involving a temporary transfer of 20,000 acre-feet (af) of water to Westlands Water District (WWD) pursuant to Water code sections 1725-1732. The transfer would involve surplus water currently stored in PCWA's Middle Fork Project under Permits 13856 and 13858 (Applications 18085 and 18087). The proposed transfer would be supplied under the combined rights, with 10,000 acre-feet transferred under each permit.

PCWA proposes to transfer 20,000 af of water currently stored in its Middle Fork Project reservoirs on the Rubicon and American Rivers to the WWD for irrigation use within the WWD service area. The following changes in the place of use and points of diversion under PCWA's permits have been requested under the petitions: 1) allow diversion of transfer water at the Harvey O. Bank's Pumping Plant and/or State Water Project's Clifton Court Forebay; and 2) allow use of transfer water for irrigation within the WWD service area. Temporary changes under Water Code section 1725 may be effective for a period of up to one year.
