Approval to Summarily Vacate a Portion of an Undeveloped Alley Located East of South 9<sup>th</sup> Street and South of Hosmer Road, Lying Northwest of the City of Ceres

#### DISCUSSION:

The abandonment application was filed by NorthStar Engineering on behalf of the adjacent landowners. The property on the north side of the alley is in the process of being re-developed, at this time the property is vacant and the owners want to maximize its potential.

The subject portion of the alley is located approximately 1.5 miles southeasterly from the City of Modesto and three miles northwesterly from the City of Ceres, south of the intersection of South 9<sup>th</sup> Street and Hosmer Road.

The alley was originally a part of the J. E. Hosmer Tract Subdivision recorded in February 1929. The adjoining alley was abandoned by the County in 1966. This portion of the alley was thought to be a part of that abandonment. The adjoining property owners have utilized the alley area under the impression it had been a part of the 1966 abandonment.

The Department of Public Works has determined that this portion of the alley is excess right-of-way. The alley has not been developed or utilized as an alley for public use. The Department of Public Works has contacted the necessary utility companies. AT&T has in-place utilities. An easement to maintain, operate, replace, remove or renew the public facilities will be retained on their behalf. The abandoned area will revert back to the adjacent land owners who currently own the underlying fee title of this property.

#### POLICY ISSUES:

The recommended actions are consistent with the Board's priority of A Well Planned Infrastructure System by removing any excess right-of-way that is not needed for road way purposes, therefore removing any liability. Street and Highways Code 8334(a) states that the legislative body of a local agency may summarily vacate excess right-of-way of a street or highway not required for street or highway purposes.

north of Lots 24, 25, 26 and 27 in said Block 3525 and


