Approval to Accept a Donation of a Reconyx Tactical Field Camera and Hyperfire Cellular Upgrade from the Cattlemen's Association

#### DISCUSSION:

The Stanislaus County Sheriff's Department Rural Crimes Unit currently maintains Surveillance Equipment for the detection and apprehension of criminals involved in the theft of property and machinery. This program has been utilized since December 2002 and has been extremely effective over the years.

The Cattlemen's Association is donating the camera due to the continued theft of rural resident's fuel, metals, livestock, and residential burglaries. The camera will be used along with existing surveillance equipment to help in the identification, apprehension, and prosecution of suspects.

Numerous surveillance operations have been conducted resulting in several suspects who have been arrested and subsequently convicted of numerous crimes. Many of the convictions were obtained prior to trial with the subjects receiving state prison sentences.

The equipment has been effective when used in areas where crime has been prevalent, from large business parks to rural areas of the community including agricultural and farmland. Criminals generally commit several thefts per night. Targeting these high theft areas with surveillance equipment has increased the number of arrests made and has been an effective tool in reducing the number of property crimes in these high crime areas. The use of additional and more sophisticated surveillance equipment will enable the Sheriff's Department to maximize its limited personnel resources and enable monitoring of multiple operations.

#### **POLICY ISSUES:**

Acceptance and recognition of this donation supports the Board priorities of A Safe Community and Efficient Delivery of Public Services and Effective Partnerships.
