DISCUSSION:

The Revenue Recovery Division of the Treasurer/Tax Collector Department maintains a large database of accounts where funds are owed to the County, Courts and various Cities.

While the County pursues accounts even to the estate of deceased people, when probate has closed or there is no estate or assets to pursue, there is no further action Revenue Recovery can take. Consequently, the likelihood of collection does not warrant the expense involved in collecting on these stale accounts.

On October 30, 2012, the Board approved the discharge of accountability of 10,211 accounts for uncollectable revenue in the amount of \$3,404,772.48 for individuals with a deceased date of 2006 or prior. This discharge of accountability included accounts from the Courts.

At this time, pursuant to Government Code Section 25257 et seq., we are requesting the Board to approve the discharge of accountability of 1,594 accounts in the amount of \$267,142.85, where the debtor is deceased as of 2007 or prior, and the accounts have been determined uncollectable. Of the 1,594 accounts, the majority are for health services though the Health Services Agency (813), mental health services through Behavioral Health and Recovery Services (341), and Public Defender services (239). This discharge of accountability does not include accounts from the Courts. The Courts are reviewing their policies and those accounts will be submitted at a later date.

POLICY ISSUES:

Discharge of accounts are approved by the Board of Supervisors pursuant to Government Code Section 25257-25258.

Approval of this agenda item will support the Board's priority of Efficient Delivery of Public Services.

STAFFING IMPACTS:

There is no staffing impact associated with this agenda item.
