Approval to Introduce and Waive the First Reading of an Ordinance to Amend Title 11, Section 11.08.080, of the Stanislaus County Code, Amending Angle Parking on Ninth Street in Stanislaus County, Keyes Area

DISCUSSION:

The Keyes to Learning Charter School located at 5709 Ninth Street in the community of Keyes has requested angle parking along Ninth Street (near the intersection of Ninth Street and Maud Avenue to slightly southeast of Stella Avenue). Currently, only parallel parking is available on Ninth Street. Angle parking is being requested to maximize the amount of parking available.

The Average Daily Traffic (ADT) for Ninth Street, near the intersection of Maud Avenue is 2,432. There are no anticipated impacts to traffic with the addition of angle parking.

After a review of this portion of Ninth Street, Department of Public Works Traffic Engineering staff recommends amending the Angle Parking Section 11.08.080 to include this portion of Ninth Street to increase the number of parking stalls available on Ninth Street.

POLICY ISSUES:

This action is consistent with the Board's priorities of providing A Safe Community, A Healthy Community and A Well Planned Infrastructure System by ensuring a safe travel way for motorists and pedestrians along this portion of the County roadway. California Vehicle Code 22506 requires Board approval to change and/or add parking zones. California Vehicle Code Section 22503 provides that local authorities may permit angle parking on any roadway.

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING STANISLAUS COUNTY CODE, SECTION 11.08.080 RELATING TO ANGLE PARKING ON NINTH STREET, IN THE KEYES AREA

"10.	Ninth Street. "On the south side of Ninth Street from a point approximately 190 feet southeast of its intersection with Maud Avenue, southeasterly 500 feet of the said intersection."
