and La Grange so the County could earn additional points in the competitive grant scoring process. The match requirement of \$82,501 will be met with off-highway vehicle revenue, and green sticker in-lieu of revenue. Revenue and expenses will be carefully tracked in the Off-Highway Vehicle Fund budget to appropriately reflect revenue and expenditures for services at the off-highway vehicle areas. State funds reimburse the Department for off-highway vehicle expenses and the Parks and Recreation General Fund is reimbursed for staff costs related to the Off-Highway Vehicle Program.

The Department requests that a budget for estimated revenue and appropriations be created to establish the Parks and Recreation Off-Highway Vehicle Fund budget for Fiscal Year 2013-2014. In the Fiscal Year 2013-2014 Adopted Proposed Budget, the Department indicated that it would return to the Board to establish the budget for the Off-Highway Vehicle Fund upon final notification of the grant award and amount. Estimated revenue from the grant, green sticker in-lieu of fees, and entrance fees are budgeted in the Off-Highway Vehicle Fund budget. The Department anticipates a return to fund balance in the amount of \$47,081 in Fiscal Year 2013-2014 as a result of estimated revenue being more than projected expenditures. The available fund balance as of July 1, 2013 is \$343,335.

DISCUSSION:

The State of California Resources Agency, Department of Parks and Recreation, Off-Highway Motor Vehicle Recreation Division, Grants and Cooperative Agreements Program, administers Operations and Maintenance grants to cities, counties, and other governmental or non-profit organizations that provide facilities relating to off-highway vehicle (OHV) activities. An OHV is defined in the California Vehicle Code as a motorcycle, snowmobile, all-terrain vehicle, jeep, sand buggy or dune buggy, and any street licensed motor vehicle being used off-highway. The Off-Highway Motor Vehicle Recreation Act of 2003 authorizes the allocation of grant funds for the purpose of establishing, maintaining, managing, and rehabilitating OHV areas, trails, and facilities in California.

Individuals and several off-road vehicle enthusiast groups enjoy both these OHV areas of La Grange and Frank Raines Regional Parks including, but not limited to: Over the Hill Gang, Central Coast RUTS, Modesto 4-Wheel Drive, California Motor Cross Association, California Outdoor Recreation Vehicle Association, East Bay High Tailers,

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American Motocross Promotions, Mutant Motor Sports, Merced Dirt Riders, and the Escarabajo Buggy Club.

On November 6, 2012, the Board of Supervisors authorized the Director of Parks and Recreation, or designee, to apply for a grant in the amount of \$440,000 from the California Resources Agency, OHV Division, Grants and Cooperative Agreements Program for Operations and Maintenance for the Off-Highway Vehicle Areas of Frank Raines and La Grange Regional Park. Staff recently received notification of the successful award of this grant in the amount of \$317,311. La Grange Off-Highway Vehicle Area was awarded a ground operations grant in the amount of \$91,517 (Attachment A) and Frank Raines Off-Highway Vehicle Area was awarded the same type of grant in the amount of \$225,794 (Attachment B). The decision to request a lesser amount was made after a pre-grant meeting when the grantees were given specific instructions to pare down requests due to limited funding. The original request was \$255,794 for Frank Raines and \$91,994 for La Grange, with a total request of \$317,788. The difference of \$477 came from an adjustment made to the indirect costs line item in the La Grange application.

The Off-Highway Vehicle Fund budget is used to track expenses and meet the grant's match requirements. Stanislaus County provides General Fund contributions in the amount of \$577,000 for law enforcement for the entire parks department which includes both of these regional facilities. Revenue is generated from fees collected for camping, dogs, horses, recreation hall use, OHV use, exclusive use, and contract agreements. The facilities generate approximately \$134,745 in revenue annually, which supports the maintenance and operations of these facilities.

Funding is used for a wide range of projects for both La Grange and Frank Raines Regional Parks. Projects include but are not limited to fencing repair and maintenance, signage, labor, purchasing office supplies and small equipment, equipment rentals, water system testing and maintenance, utilities, and administrative overhead.

POLICY ISSUE:

Approval of these actions supports the Boards' priorities of Effective Partnerships, A Well Planned Infrastructure System, A Healthy Community, and the Efficient Delivery of Public Services by providing special recreation facilities to County residents and visitors through partnerships with organizations that provide grant funding resources for maintenance and operations of park lands and facilities.

STAFFING IMPACTS:

The recommended action will fund 74% of 1 FTE and extra-help staff time of approximately 6,900 hours between the two parks for Fiscal Year 2013-2014.
