#### **DISCUSSION:**

Chapter 3.28 of the County Code establishes procedures for appeals from disciplinary actions for classified employees of the County. Compliance with this Code calls for the Board of Supervisors to appoint a three member Appeals Board to one-year terms to hear and decide upon disciplinary matters as well as to serve as the final step in the County's Equal Opportunity Grievance Procedure. The Appeals Board is composed of an employee chosen from among the nominees of employee organizations, a Department Head, and a practicing attorney who is not a member of County service and who serves as chairperson of the Appeals Board.

#### **POLICY ISSUE:**

The County Code provides that the Board of Supervisors approves the appointment of members of the Appeals Board.

#### STAFFING IMPACT:

There is no staffing impact associated with this recommendation. Existing staff will continue to administer the Appeals Board.
