SUBJECT:

Approval to Introduce and Waive the First Reading of an Ordinance to Amend Title 11, Section 11.08.020: Red Curb Marking - Streets Designated, of the Stanislaus County Code, to Include Bangs Avenue in Stanislaus County, Modesto Area

STAFF RECOMMENDATIONS:

- 1) Find that the subject ordinance change is not subject to the California Environmental Quality Act (Public Resources Code, Sections 2100 et. seq.).
- 2) Introduce and waive the first reading of an ordinance amending Title 11, Section 11.08.020: Red Curb Marking - Streets Designated, of the Stanislaus County Code, to include Bangs Avenue, in Stanislaus County, Modesto area.

FISCAL IMPACT:

The application of red paint on the curb along the proposed portion of Bangs Avenue will cost the Department of Public Works approximately \$3,810 (including the refreshing of existing striping & new "no parking" signs) with no significant increase in the annual cost for maintenance. Funding is available in the current year's Road and Bridge Operations budget.



Approval to Introduce and Waive the First Reading of an Ordinance to Amend Title 11, Section 11.08.020: Red Curb Marking - Streets Designated, of the Stanislaus County Code, to Include Bangs Avenue in Stanislaus County, Modesto Area

DISCUSSION:

A parking issue was brought to the attention of Public Works staff by a resident along Bangs Avenue near the intersection of McHenry Avenue. Vehicles are currently allowed to park on Bangs Avenue near the intersection. This impedes sight distance at the intersection and reduces the lane clearance of the travel way making it difficult for vehicles such as trucks and buses making turns to maneuver through the intersection.

A Traffic Engineering staff site review of the Bangs Avenue/McHenry Avenue intersection recommends amending the No Parking Section 11.08.020 to include a total of approximately 1,200 feet of No Parking on Bangs Avenue near the intersection of McHenry. The proposed additional No Parking Zones to Bangs Avenue will reduce potential conflicts between turning vehicles and parked vehicles by improving sight distance.

The proposed No Parking zones on Bangs Avenue are as follows:

- 460 feet west of McHenry Avenue (North and South side)
- 140 feet east of McHenry Avenue (North and South side)

POLICY ISSUES:

This action is consistent with the Board's priorities of providing A Well Planned Infrastructure System by ensuring a safe travel way for motorists and pedestrians along this portion of the County roadway. California Vehicle Code 22506 requires Board approval to change and/or add parking zones.

STAFFING IMPACT:

There is no staffing impact associated with this item.

ORDINANCE NO. C.S. _____

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING STANISLAUS COUNTY CODE,
SECTION 11.08.020 RELATING TO RED CURB MARKING – STREETS DESIGNATED
ON BANGS AVENUE, IN THE MODESTO AREA

**THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF STANISLAUS ORDAINS AS
FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. Amend the Stanislaus County Code, Section 11.08.020: Red Curb Marking – Streets Designated to add, Paragraph 540 to read as follows:

“540. Bangs Avenue. On the north and south sides of Bangs Avenue from its intersection thereof with McHenry Avenue, west to a point four hundred and sixty feet of said intersection; and on the north and south sides of Bangs Avenue from its intersection thereof with McHenry Avenue, east to a point one-hundred and forty feet of said intersection.”

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect 30 days from and after the date of its passage, and before the expiration of 15 days after its passage, it shall be published once with the names of the members voting for and against the same in the Modesto Bee, a newspaper in the County of Stanislaus, State of California.






