

ORDINANCE NO. C.S. 1151

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING STANISLAUS COUNTY CODE,
SECTION 11.08.020 RELATING TO RED CURB MARKING – STREETS DESIGNATED
AND SECTION 11.08.120 RELATING TO NO TRUCK PARKING ON LECKRON ROAD, IN THE
MODESTO AREA

**THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF STANISLAUS ORDAINS AS
FOLLOWS:**

Section 1 Amend the Stanislaus County Code, Section 11.08.020: Red Curb Marking - Streets Designated, Paragraph 438 to read as follows:

“438 Leckron Road. On the south side of Leckron Road from its intersection with Codoni Road, to a point 430 feet west of said intersection; and on the south side of Leckron Road from a point 700 feet west of its intersection with Codoni Road, to a point 825 feet west of said intersection; and on the north side of Leckron Road from its intersection to with Codoni Road, to a point 180 feet west of said intersection; and on the north side of Leckron Road from a point 700 feet west of its intersection with Codoni Road, to a point 825 feet west of said intersection.”

Section 2 Amend the Stanislaus County Code, Section 11.08.120: No Truck Parking to add, Subsection 28 (Truck parking is prohibited on the following county streets and highways), as follows:

“28 Leckron Road. On the south side of Leckron Road from a point 430 feet west of its intersection with Codoni Road, west 270 feet, to a point 700 feet west of said intersection; and on the north side of Leckron Road from a point 180 feet west of its intersection with Codoni Road, west 520 feet to a point 700 feet west of said intersection.”

Section 3 These ordinances shall take effect 30 days from and after the date of its passage, and before the expiration of 15 days after its passage, it shall be published once with the names of the members voting for and against the same in the Modesto Bee, a newspaper in the County of Stanislaus, State of California.

Upon motion of Supervisor Monteith, seconded by Supervisor Withrow, the foregoing ordinance as passed and adopted at a regular meeting of the Board of Supervisors of the County of Stanislaus, State of California, this 15th day of July, 2014, by the following called vote.





Section 1. Amend the Stanislaus County Code, Section 11.08.020: Red Curb Marking - Streets Designated, Paragraph 438 to read as follows: "438 Leckron Road. On the south side of Leckron Road from its intersection with Codoni Road, to a point 430 feet west of said intersection; and on the south side of Leckron Road from a point 700 feet west of its intersection with Codoni Road, to a point 825 feet west of said intersection; and on the north side of Leckron Road from its intersection to with Codoni Road, to a point 180 feet west of said intersection; and on the north side of Leckron Road from a point 700 feet west of its intersection with Codoni Road, to a point 825 feet west of said intersection."

Section 2. Amend the Stanislaus County Code, Section 11.08.120: No Truck Parking to add, Subsection 28 (Truck parking is prohibited on the following county streets and highways), as follows: "28 Leckron Road. On the south side of Leckron Road from a point 430 feet west of its intersection with Codoni Road, west 270 feet, to a point 700 feet west of said intersection; and on the north side of Leckron Road from a point 180 feet west of its intersection with Codoni Road, west 520 feet to a point 700 feet west of said intersection."

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect 30 days from and after the date of its passage, and before the expiration of 15 days after its passage, it shall be published once with the names of the members voting for and against the same in the Modesto Bee, a newspaper in the County of Stanislaus, State of California.
