Approval to Adopt a Resolution Authorizing the Execution of the Certification and Assurances Public Transportation, Modernization, and Service Enhancement Account (PTMISEA) Bond Program Grant for Fiscal Year 2014-2015

DISCUSSION:

The FY14-15 Public Transportation Modernization, Improvement, and Service Enhancement Account is the ninth in a series of capital transit funding grants from the California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) and administered by the Division of Mass Transportation. PTMISEA grants provide funding for transit capital projects such as bus purchases, procurement of transit amenities, as well as bus stop improvements. Locally, in prior years, the grant funded the purchase of fixed route and paratransit buses, Genfare fareboxes, transit amenities and improvements to the bus transfer location in the City of Patterson.

The County's Public Works Transit Division is the eligible applicant and recipient for the PTMISEA transit capital grant in the County. The Transit Division submitted the FY 14-15 grant application to Caltrans on July 14, 2014. Caltrans is requesting the Stanislaus County governing board approve a resolution authorizing the execution of the Certification and Assurances for the County's FY 14-15 PTMISEA grant application.

The amount available to Stanislaus County for FY 14-15 is \$33,490 and will be used in conjunction with prior PTMISEA grants awarded to Stanislaus County to fund transit capital projects in the County. Once the County's PTMISEA grant application is approved by Caltrans, an agenda item seeking approval to procure paratransit CNG buses will be submitted to the Board of Supervisors.

POLICY ISSUES:

Approval of this action supports the Board's priority of A Well Planned Infrastructure System and Efficient Delivery of Public Services by providing for a public transit system that is compliant with State efficiency standards.
