Approval to Accept the Fiscal Year 2014-2015 Grant from the Department of Insurance for the District Attorney's Office Auto Insurance Fraud Program

## FISCAL IMPACT: (Continued)

Insurance Fraud Program fund budget. The District Attorney signed the grant agreement on August 27, 2014 pending Board of Supervisors approval and a formal Board of Supervisors resolution. The grant will fund salaries and benefits for a Criminal Investigator at 100% and a Deputy District Attorney at 42%. The grant will also fund operating expenditures to include wireless communications, audit expenditures, training for the Auto Insurance Fraud staff and equipment. Retirements in the department's paralegal division continue to cause under-staffing. The paralegal that was assigned to the Auto Insurance Fraud Unit now works outside of the grant. The District Attorney's General Fund will fund the remaining 58% of the Deputy District Attorney position for whom this is a collateral assignment.

#### **DISCUSSION:**

In Fiscal Year 1996-1997, the District Attorney's Office was awarded funding for the Automobile Insurance Fraud Grant. This will make Fiscal Year 2014-2015 the eighteenth consecutive year that the District Attorney's Office will have received funding from the California Department of Insurance for the Automobile Insurance Fraud Grant.

Insurance fraud affects the citizens of Stanislaus County through increased insurance rates. The District Attorney's Office is committed to the investigation and prosecution of those who commit insurance fraud; the acceptance of the California Department of Insurance's Automobile Insurance Fraud Prosecution grant has allowed this investigation and prosecution to occur. This agenda item is being submitted for Board approval in order to authorize acceptance of the grant and to authorize the District Attorney to sign the final grant award. A formal resolution is attached.

In Fiscal Year 2014-2015, the objectives of the grant will continue to focus on economic vehicle theft and its relation to auto insurance fraud. The Criminal Investigator will continue to work with the Stanislaus County Auto Theft Task Force.

## **POLICY ISSUES:**

Acceptance of this grant will assist the District Attorney's Office continue to meet the Board's goal of A Safe Community by investigating and prosecuting those who commit auto insurance fraud.

## **STAFFING IMPACTS:**

The grant funds 100% of an Investigator and 42% of a Deputy District Attorney. These staffing levels are able to sustain the reporting requirements of the grant.

Stanislaus County's request for the use of projected carry-over funds from Fiscal Year 2013/14 has been reviewed. Based upon your justification, the Department of Insurance has approved Stanislaus County's request to carry-over \$40,528 of the \$50,425 projected carry-over into Fiscal Year 2014/15.

The spending authority for this carry-over is contingent on the submission and approval of a 2014/15 modified budget that totals to \$202,639. This total incorporates the following amounts:

- \$162,111 Grant Award for Fiscal Year 2014/15
- \$40,528 in projected carry-over from Fiscal Year 2013/14 for use into Fiscal Year 2014/15

Please submit this modified budget by October 29, 2014.
