SUBJECT:

STAFF RECOMMENDATIONS:

Set a Public Hearing on April 28, 2015 at 9:05 a.m. to introduce and waive the first reading of an ordinance to establish new fees and amend existing fees, for the Department of Public Works.

FISCAL IMPACT:

The proposed fees will enable the Department of Public Works to recover the cost of providing specific services to the general public, development community and other county departments. Based on the current year's activity, the proposed fees are anticipated to generate approximately \$34,000 in additional revenue. Actual revenues will vary depending on the number of permit applications, plan reviews, and inspections.

Approval to Set a Public Hearing on April 28, 2015 at 9:05 a.m. to Introduce and Waive the First Reading of an Ordinance to Establish New Fees and Amend Existing Fees, for the Department of Public Works

FISCAL IMPACT (Continued):

The proposed increase is based on an average rate of \$95 per hour for construction engineering services, \$105 per hour for plan checking and engineering services and \$90 per hour for survey services, which is the current weighted labor rate for the personnel performing these tasks. These fees were last updated in 2013. Additionally, two new fees, one for Traffic Delay Notifications and one for Pipeline Maintenance Agreements are proposed to be added to recover costs for services. A \$20 increase per encroachment permit for National Pollution Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) Municipal Separate Storm Sewer System (MS4) Phase II Permit implementation is also recommended.

The increase in revenue resulting from the approval of the proposed fees is expected to offset direct costs related to processing Encroachment Permits, Excavation Permits, Grading Permits, Street Improvement Permits and Construction Inspections as well as the associated costs in implementing the MS4 Phase II Permit. This existing fee amendment will also be used by the Planning Department to assist in processing permits associated with grading and land development/land use applications.

DISCUSSION:

The Public Works Department provides services, as required by law, to the public and the development community. Some of these services encompass construction inspection, plan review, and project review. Public Works charges fees to recoup the costs of providing these inspection and review services.

The last fee update was performed in 2013. Public Works staff reviewed the fee structure and has recommendations for fee adjustments and two new fees. Public Works proposes to use \$95 per hour for construction inspection and \$105 an hour for plan checking as a baseline for setting fees. The proposed fees are based on the average amount of time it normally takes to perform the various inspections.

FEE REVIEW PROCESS

To determine the appropriateness of existing fees and identify any need for change, Public Works utilizes the following process:

- Ongoing analysis is conducted on an annual basis to determine if revenue from individual fees is sufficient to cover staff time and costs to support each function that has a fee.
- In reviewing the fee structure, Public Works identifies those fees that had not kept pace with both the amount of staff time and/or the cost of staff time to complete the task as shown in Exhibit "A".
- Public Works' Engineering staff contacts other California counties to obtain information about

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the fees they charge for Plan Checks, Encroachment Permits, Excavation Permits, Street Improvement Construction Permits, Construction Inspections, and Land Survey services. For the 2015 comparison the following counties were contacted Fresno, Kern, Kings, Madera, Merced, Monterey, Sacramento, San Joaquin, Solano, Sonoma, Tulare, and Ventura.

A spreadsheet (Exhibit "B") was developed listing the fees charged by those government entities along with the current Stanislaus County Public Works fees.

- The fees charged by other government entities are averaged and compared with Stanislaus County fees. In addition, the variation in methods for charging the fees is also evaluated. Variations include a flat rate, charging actual time taken to perform the services, and requiring deposits based on a percentage of the engineer's estimated cost to complete the project, and distinguishing between major and minor projects or commercial and residential projects.

Proposed Fee Changes of Existing Fees

Engineering Fees

Excavation Permit (for any excavation occurring in a County right-of-way): The basic permit fee is proposed to increase from \$20 to \$40. This fee includes \$5 each for Flood Plain Administrator review and Geographic Information System (GIS) updates as related to the improvements, \$10 for administrative fees and a proposed \$20 for a stormwater permit implementation charge. The stormwater permit implementation fee is to help offset the costs of the Phase II MS4 NPDES permit. Public Works incurs significant costs in the implementation of this permit and many of the activities that we monitor are directly construction related. This proposed fee would generate approximately \$10,000 per year.

Construction Permits: The base permit fee is \$40 and includes \$5 each for Flood Plain Administrator review and GIS updates as related to the improvements and \$30 for administrative fees. A \$20 stormwater permit implementation fee is recommended, which would increase the construction permit to \$60. Fees are to be paid in advance of the inspection.

For large construction projects, a deposit of 10% of the engineer's estimate is required based on cost of the construction. Inspection time would be charged at the rate of \$95 per hour, the charge being drawn down against the deposit. At the completion of the project, the balance of the deposit would be remitted to the customer. If the deposit is not sufficient to cover all inspection charges, the customer will be billed separately for additional charges. The standard rate per hour for construction inspection is proposed to remain at \$95 per hour.

Grading Permit: This fee is collected by the Department of Planning on Public Works' behalf for services to review and approve grading plans and provide required field inspections for projects requiring a grading permit as determined by the Department of Planning.

The existing Permit application processing fee of \$30 is proposed to be increased to \$50 to

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include a \$20 stormwater permit implementation charge. Field inspections and plan reviews will be based on actual cost/minimum charge at the weighted labor rate of \$95 per hour. A deposit will be required based on the risk level as discussed above.

Plan Checking: Improvement plan checking is proposed to increase to \$105 per hour from the existing \$95 per hour. The proposed increase is to recover additional costs incurred with plan checking. As with large construction projects, a deposit of 10% of the engineer's estimate for the total cost of the project would be required, and inspection time would be charged back against the deposit.

Proposed New Fees

There is no current fee for Pipeline Maintenance Agreements (PMA), which are used to allow private or public crossings of the County right-of-way. The PMA ensures that the pipe owner is responsible for the maintenance of the pipe crossing for as long as the pipe is in our road. Due to the extended drought, Public Works has received approximately 30 of these requests per year for the last two years. As these are recorded documents and staff spends approximately 3 hours on each PMA, we are proposing a flat fee of \$285 for routine PMAs and then the ability to recover additional time spent at the current weighted labor rate for plan review on more complicated PMAs. The \$285 PMA fee is based upon 3 hours of staff time which is the average amount of time spent on PMAs. Sonoma County charges a minimum of \$835 or actual cost, whichever is greater, and San Joaquin County charges actual cost.

Staff recommends a fee for processing Traffic Delay Notifications (TDN). In calendar year 2014, Public Works processed 46 TDNs that were encroachment permit related. TDNs involve notification of many different agencies, districts and media outlets. On average, staff spends 2 hours on a TDN; therefore, the TDN fee is recommended to be \$190, or two hours of staff time at \$95 per hour. Fresno County charges \$288 per TDN. The proposed fee schedule is shown as Exhibit "A" in this document.

POLICY ISSUES:

Authority for the Department of Public Works to charge fees for use of County roads and inspection of constructions, excavations, and installations occurring in Stanislaus County streets is granted in California Street and Highways Code Chapter 5.5, Article 2, Section 1464. Authority for those fees associated with building permits is granted by California Health and Safety Code Section 17950.

This action is consistent with the Board's priorities of A Well-Planned Infrastructure System and the Efficient Delivery of Public Services by ensuring that inspection services can continue to be provided in a timely manner.

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STAFFING IMPACT:

The proposed increases will enable Public Works staff to continue to provide services to the general public, development community and other County departments.

AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND EXISTING FEES COLLECTED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS

Section 1. Section 2. 

(1) Fees described above that require a deposit and are charged at "actual cost" have a minimum charge associated with them. The deposit required is the minimum charge and is non-refundable. This DOES NOT include any necessary consultant costs for environmental review, specialized studies, financial consulting or any other expert consulting services potentially needed by the County for processing these applications. Monthly draws against the deposit will be made based on staff time and materials needed to process the applications. Staff costs and expenses will be billed at fully burdened weighted labor rates at the time of services rendered.

All additional staff time and expenses needed to complete the application processing that exceed the deposit amount will be charged at actual cost, including labor charged at the weighted labor rate. Invoices will be calculated on a quarterly basis and forwarded to the applicant for balance of payment. If the deposit reaches 20% of the initial deposit or less, the Applicant will be asked to make a subsequent deposit in an amount dependent upon the amount of work left to complete on processing. Applicants will be expected to pay the subsequent deposit within 30 days of invoice date. In the event that the account is not paid within 30 days of the invoice date, processing will be suspended until such time that payment is made. Any remainder will be used to reconcile the final bill. If there is a balance remaining after reconciling the final bill, a refund check will be mailed to applicant. Public hearings will not be scheduled until payment in full is received.

*(2) Department of Public Works charges for Condition of Approval or Development Standards Modifications, Parcel Maps, and Use Permits reflect a minimum charge of 5 hours at a weighted labor rate of \$90 per hour. Additional time required for these requests will be charged at \$95 per hour for construction engineering services, or \$105 per hour for plan checking/engineering services.

*(3) Fees described above that require a deposit and are charged at "actual cost". Staff costs and expenses will be billed at fully burdened weighted labor rates at the time of services rendered. Any deposit balance remaining at the completion of the project will be reimbursed to the applicant.

* Fees may be refunded if the Planning Director, or his appointed designee, determines extraordinary circumstance warranting a refund exist.

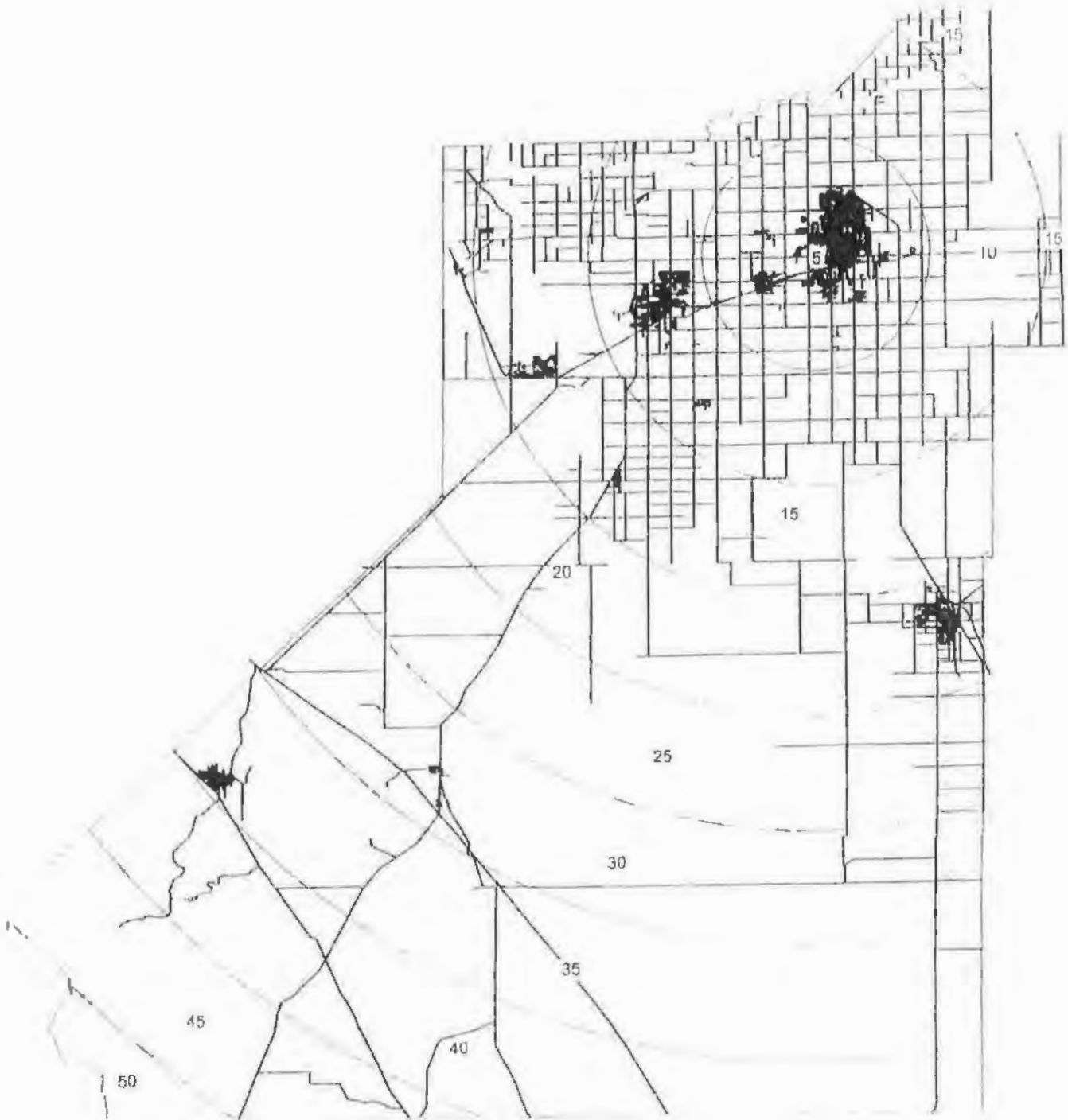

ORDINANCE NO. 1860

**AN ORDINANCE TO ADJUST THE FEES FOR ENCROACHMENT PERMIT FEES
(Amending Ordinance No. 1841 and Section 13.30.030 of the Merced County Code)**

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Merced, State of California, ordains as follows:

Section 1: Section 13.30.030 of the Merced County Code is amended to read as follows:

13.30.30 Fees

Section 1464 of the Streets and Highways Code provides that the Director may require a permittee to pay the reasonable costs for supervision of work performed under an encroachment permit.

The County shall be reimbursed for expenses incurred as a result of this Chapter including costs associated with the issuance of Encroachment Permits and for the costs that are associated with inspection of the construction of the encroachment.

Encroachment Permit fees shall be collected prior to the issuance of an Encroachment Permit. No part of any permit fee may be refunded to an applicant. The Director may waive the fee requirements for specific applications when it is deemed to be in the best interest of the County.

Encroachment Permit fees shall be as follows:

Section 2, Validity: If any section, subsection, paragraph, sentence, clause, word or phrase of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or otherwise invalid, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remainder of the Ordinance. The Board of Supervisors hereby declares that they would have passed this Ordinance, and each section, subsection, paragraph, sentence, clause, word or phrase thereof, irrespective of the fact that any one or more section, subsection, paragraph, sentence, clause, word or phrase be declared unconstitutional or invalid.

Section 3, Enactment: This Ordinance shall become effective and be in full force sixty (60) days from the passage and adoption, and prior to the expiration of fifteen (15) days from the passage thereof, shall be published in a newspaper of general circulation

Merced County Code

Title 13 HIGHWAYS

Chapter 13.30 ENCROACHMENT PERMIT PROVISIONS

13.30.010 Purpose.

The purpose of this chapter is to supplement the Streets and Highway Code, Division 2, Chapter 5.5, The Care and Protection of County Highways by defining the procedures which the county will follow and the fees that will be charged related to the issuance of encroachment permits on county highways. All individuals, contractors, corporations, utilities, and other governmental agencies proposing to conduct any activity not authorized by the vehicle code, within, under or over any county roadway must first obtain an encroachment permit issued by the county prior to conducting that activity. However, contractors already under contract with the road division of public works to perform work within such roadways or private and public surveyors conducting activities within said roadways are not required to obtain an encroachment permit. (Ord. 1635 § 2, 1999; Ord. 1459, 1993).

13.30.020 Definitions.

“Annual utility permit” means a permit issued to a utility authorizing routine maintenance activities within county road right-of-way.

“Director” means the director of the department of public works, who is also the road commissioner, for the county of Merced or his or her authorized representative.

“Franchise and/or confirmation of rights agreement” means an agreement issued by Merced County authorizing and establishing certain conditions for providing specific utility services or products within Merced County.

“Inspector” means the representative of the director authorized to inspect, sample, or test the construction of an encroachment on a county highway.

“Minor project” means a project having a construction cost of three thousand dollars (\$3,000.00) or less.

“Non-franchised utility” means a utility company providing service within Merced County without benefit of a county-issued franchise or confirmation of rights agreement.

“Specific maintenance project permit” means a permit issued to a utility authorizing the replacement of existing overhead facilities when the scope of that maintenance exceeds the authority granted in the annual utility permit as defined in Appendix A of the department of public works improvement and specifications manual.

“Utility” means a public or private company, district and/or corporation providing any one or more of the following products or services: electricity, natural gas or other petroleum products, telephone, telecommunications, cable T.V., domestic water, sewer companies, and irrigation companies or districts. (Ord. 1635 § 2, 1999; Ord. 1459, 1993).

13.30.030 Fees.

Section 1464 of the Streets and Highways Code provides that the director may require a permittee to pay the reasonable costs for supervision of work performed under an encroachment permit.

The county shall be reimbursed for expenses incurred as a result of this chapter including costs associated with the inspection of the construction of the encroachment.

Encroachment permit fees shall be collected prior to the issuance of an encroachment permit. No part of any permit fee may be refunded to an applicant. The director may waive the fee requirements for specific applications when it is deemed to be in the best interest of the county.

13.30.040 Encroachments.

A. Encroachment Permits Manual. The booklet entitled Manual of policy, procedures, rides and regulations for use in issuing encroachment permits on state highways in California will be used by the department of public works as a guideline for issuing encroachment permits on Merced County highways. When referenced, language in the booklet will be appropriately adjusted to provide for the nature of encroachments expected on county highways as opposed to state highways.

B. Encroachment Permit Application Requirements.

1. Applications for encroachment permits shall be applied for at the road division of the department of public works.

2. On minor projects the applicant may be required to provide improvement plans prepared by a professional licensed to perform such work and on major projects all improvement plans shall be prepared by a professional as required by state law.

3. If the proposed encroachment involves altering facilities under the jurisdiction of a storm drainage, sewer, water, irrigation district or private individual, applicant shall submit a letter from the district or private individual giving the applicant permission to alter their facilities.

4. Applicant is required by Section 3800 of the California Labor Code to provide the department of public works with a certification of workman's compensation insurance.

5. Whenever the construction or installation of a structure proposed to encroach on a county highway will require the making of an excavation, applicant shall satisfy the following additional requirements:

a. Trenches will be allowed to be open only during daylight hours. All excavations made in conjunction with an encroachment permit shall be either backfilled or covered in conformance with the requirements of the inspector before dusk; and

b. When construction is complete, all excavations shall be backfilled and structural section replaced as specified in the Merced County improvement standards and specifications; and

c. The director may require boring as opposed to trenching on highways with a paved surface that is in very good condition or on highways with traffic volumes that cannot be easily detoured. The director may require changes in the application as to the location, dimensions, character and number of the proposed excavations necessary for the protection of county highways or for the prevention of undue interference of traffic or the safety of persons using county highways.

6. Encroachment Improvement Security.

a. Major projects shall be required to post securities in the amount of one hundred (100) percent of the estimated construction cost to guarantee the faithful performance of the construction or installation of improvements, and an amount of fifty (50) percent of the estimated construction cost shall be required to secure the payment to the contractor, subcontractors and to persons furnishing labor, materials or equipment for the construction or installation of improvements.

b. Applicants for other types of encroachment permits, including utility projects are not required to provide the department of public works with improvement security. However, all work must be completed as required in subsection F of this section.

7. No part of this chapter shall prohibit any person from making emergency repairs to any pipe or conduit within county highways, or from making excavations as may be necessary for the preservation of life or property if time is of the essence or such emergency arises during such hours as the offices of the county are closed. The agent responsible for such encroachment shall notify the department of public works within the first business day that office is open subsequent to making said emergency repairs.

C. Utility Encroachment Permits. The department of public works will issue the following two types of encroachment permits to utility companies occupying the road right-of-way:

1. Annual maintenance permits, which authorizes all those maintenance and emergency repairs specified in the current Appendix A of the Merced County department of public works improvement standards and specifications manual.

2. Specific maintenance permits, which authorizes the replacement of existing overhead facilities when the scope of that maintenance exceeds authority granted in the annual maintenance permit. Limits and conditions for this permit are specified in the current Appendix A of the Merced County department of public works improvement standards and specifications manual.

3. Specific project permit authorizes all new construction projects and all work performed outside the scope authorized in the above described annual maintenance permit or the specific maintenance permit. Utility companies proposing to construct or place new facilities adjacent to county road right-of-way and within the recovery zone defined in Appendix A of the current edition of the Merced County department of public works improvement standards and specifications manual are required to obtain a specific project permit prior to installation of the facility.

D. Construction Signing. When required, applicant shall submit construction detour plans. All construction signing shall be in conformance with the CALTRANS Traffic Manual and the requirements of the director.

E. Inspection.

1. Applicant shall notify the department of public works, road division at least twenty-four (24) hours prior to the commencement of any work covered by an encroachment permit. Except that in the case of an emergency notification shall take place as soon as possible but in no case any longer than the end of the next working day.

2. A qualified representative of water, storm drainage, sewer districts or other utility engineer shall inspect and certify the installation of encroachment owned and maintained by the district.

F. Completion of Work Permitted by an Encroachment Permit. The applicant shall perform all work in accordance with the Merced County Improvement Standards and Specifications, any special provisions required in the encroachment permit, and in conformance with any improvement plans to the satisfaction of the director.

1. Every applicant shall diligently complete the work within the time period stipulated in the encroachment permit.

2. If the applicant fails to complete the work within the time period stipulated on the encroachment permit, the director, or his representative, may revoke the permit or, if sufficient reasons exist, the director, or his representative may extend the time period allotted to complete the work.

3. The applicant shall make proper arrangements for, and bear the cost of, relocating any structure, public utility, tree, or shrub, where such relocation is made necessary by the proposed work for which a permit is issued.

4. If after the work has begun, the applicant fails or refuses to complete the work as prescribed in the encroachment permit, the director, or his representative, may cause such work to be done, either by county forces or by an outside contractor, and any expense incurred by the county will be born by the applicant. (Ord. 1635 § 2, 1999; Ord. 1459, 1993).

13.30.050 Enforcement, procedures and penalties.

A. The Director is authorized to issue citations to persons in violation of this chapter of the code.

B. Any person, firm or corporation, whether as principal, agent, lessee, occupant, or otherwise in violation of this chapter is guilty of a misdemeanor with penalties as specified in Section 1.28.030 of this code. (Ord. 1635 § 2, 1999; Ord. 1459, 1993).

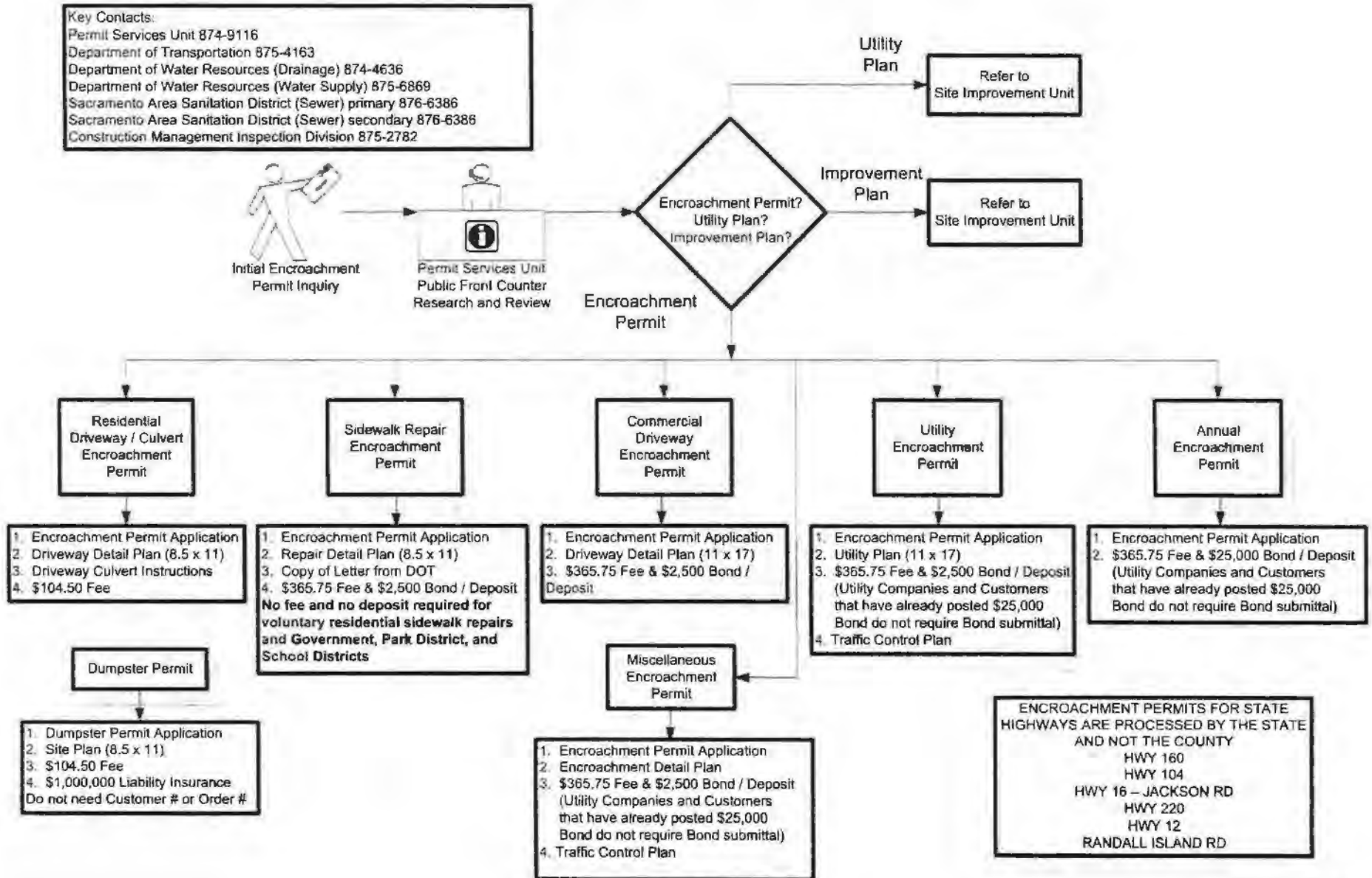
