Project One (Maximum-Security, Medical/Mental Health Units) and Project Three (Intake, Release, Transportation) are making outstanding construction progress. With today's actions, Project Two (Day Reporting Center) is recommended for approval of final acceptance and completion of construction.

At this time, staff is requesting the Board of Supervisors approve the final contract with Simile Construction Service, Inc. of Modesto, California for the final contract cost of \$4,018,696. During the course of construction, the Project Manager processed change order requests totaling \$241,696, consistent with the County's Change Order Policy, which increased the final contract cost from \$3,777,000 to \$4,018,696. As the awarding authority, the Board of Supervisors is also requested to authorize the Project Manager to sign the completion documents, record the Notice of Completion effective August 7, 2015, release retention less withholdings, and process all remaining closeout activities for the above contracts and the project.

The construction of the Day Reporting Center resulted in a modern, efficient facility for the rehabilitation of offenders. The Project Manager will return to the Board of Supervisors if the need arises to dedicate project funds from Project Two towards other appropriate uses of the Public Safety Center Expansion project construction effort, including reallocating remaining unexpended appropriations to Project One for the successfully delivery of the entire AB 900 Phase II Public Safety Center Expansion.

DISCUSSION:

The Public Safety Center Expansion Projects are comprised of the following three elements:

Project One (Maximum-Security, Medical/Mental Health Units) -Included two maximum-security housing units (240 beds each), special needs housing unit, medical and mental health housing unit (72 beds), health services facility and security administration, to be funded 90% by Assembly Bill/AB 900 Phase II funding and 10% by County matching funds.

Project Two (Day Reporting Center) - Included the Programs / Day Reporting Center, to be funded 90% by Assembly Bill/AB 900 Phase II funding and 10% by County matching funds.

Project Three (Intake, Release, Transportation) - Included various support facilities, to be funded entirely by County funds through money set aside from Public Facility Fees.

Project Two (Day Reporting Center)

The design-build construction of Project Two (Day Reporting Center) was completed in less than one (1) year from the date of the groundbreaking. This facility is the first 2011 Local Jail Construction Financing Program, AB 900 Phase II project to be constructed and completed in the State of California. The innovative programs facility, constructed by Simile Construction Service, Inc. of Modesto, California and its 70 local and regional subcontracted partners, resulted in the creation of over 300 construction related jobs.

The Day Reporting Center includes a coordination of offender services offered by the County including three key County Departments: Probation, Sheriff's Office and Behavioral Health and Recovery Services (BHRS). Various non-profits and program providers will also use the facility to engage offenders in classroom oriented training such as GED preparation, job skills and counseling services with the end goal to break the cycle of recidivism in our community

The new Day Reporting Center includes a public reception lobby, six (6) classrooms, a computer lab, eight (8) interview rooms and an outdoor break area focused around the need to provide rehabilitative services to the offender population. The key County Departments will occupy a secure administrative area which includes a team work area, private offices, conference room, break room and locker rooms. In addition, a medications disbursement services wing has been included adjacent to the public entry lobby for BHRS to provide mental health rehabilitative and treatment services, when appropriate.

The Probation Department Staff will relocate from the existing Interim Day Reporting Center at 801 11th Street, Modesto. The Sheriff's Office will occupy a small portion of the facility to participate in the continuum of care services needed for in-custody and out of custody rehabilitation of inmates and offenders.

BHRS will be transferring the operation of its Community Corrections Annex for Medications at 825 12th Street, Modesto to the new Day Reporting Center. BHRS will provide mental health treatment services as part of the overall continuum of care of out-of-custody offenders as an effort to reduce the likelihood of recidivism to County jail.

Construction Site Progress

Project Two (Day Reporting Center) met substantial completion on July 8, 2015. With today's actions the Project Manager is seeking to provide Final Completion effective August 7, 2015. The Project Manager will conduct an appropriate public dedication ceremonies to recognize this accomplishment to be held on August 13, 2015. This new facility is a key component in the County's justice system.

The larger Project One (Maximum-Security, Medical/Mental Health Units) and the County funded Project Three (Intake, Release, Transportation) are both under construction at this time.

Schedule

It is anticipated that Probation, the Sheriff's Office and Behavioral Health and Recovery Services (BHRS) will relocate to the new facility and commence program services shortly after the public dedication event on August 13, 2015.

Construction completion for Project One (Maximum-Security, Medical/Mental Health Units) and Project Three (Intake, Release, Transportation) is anticipated in late Fall 2016 to Spring 2017. Construction of the projects will have a significant positive impact in terms of construction-related employment locally and off-site and result in a considerable public safety improvement.

POLICY ISSUES:

These actions will advance the Board of Supervisors' priority to strive for A Safe Community by increasing detention capacity to meet projected needs and the use of alternatives to incarceration, and program opportunity consistent with the Public Safety Realignment.

These actions also support the Board's priority to provide Efficient Delivery of Public Services in pursuing State funds by leveraging limited County resources effectively.

STAFFING IMPACTS:

The existing Project Team will continue to focus on the successful completion of this major public safety center construction effort.






