## FISCAL IMPACT (CONTINUED):

All expenses associated with the development and the construction of this project will be funded by PFF funds for Regional Parks, Fund 2405. As of June 30, 2015, the unobligated balance of Fund 2405, which includes this project, is approximately \$2.7 million.

#### **DISCUSSION:**

Stanislaus County owns and maintains Woodward Reservoir Regional Park (WRRP), which is located at 14528 26-Mile Road, near the City of Oakdale. The WRRP consists of 3,500 acres, in which approximately 2,150 acres are designated for outdoor recreational activities such as swimming, boating, fishing, and camping.

The purpose of the Project is to expand recreational camping facilities at the WRRP by adding new infrastructure and upgrading existing infrastructure to support the Project's improvements. Once the Project is constructed, the WRRP will have an additional 61 full service campsites with new sewer, water, electrical facilities, and Recreational Vehicle (RV) hookups. The Project will also significantly upgrade the existing aging sewer, water, and electrical infrastructure. The Project's improvements are:

- 1. Provide 41 new sewer and electrical services with RV hookups at T-Island Campground.
- 2. Retrofit existing restroom at T-Island Campground to be ADA accessible.
- 3. Reconstruct existing lift station at T-Island Campground.
- 4. Upgrade the existing sewer force main from T-Island Campground to the existing sewer force main junction at Hackberry Flat Campground.
- 5. Provide 20 new sewer and electrical services with RV hookups at Muir Point Campground.
- 6. Construct new lift station at Muir Point Campground.
- 7. Install sewer gravity conveyance system at T-Island and Muir Point Campgrounds.
- 8. Upgrade the existing electrical service at Muir Point and T-Island Campgrounds.
- 9. Upgrade the existing electrical infrastructure for Hackberry Flat Campground.

In 1999, the Board of Supervisors approved Parks Master Plan, which included the development of WRRP. On April 17, 2012, the Board of Supervisors approved a request for the use of PFF funds in the amount of \$4,535,162 to purchase additional equipment and amenities for various parks. This request included \$1,899,740 specifically allocated for the development and the construction of this project.

Parks solicited the services of Department of Public Works (Public Works). Public Works assisted Parks with the consultant selection and other various project management services associated with the development and construction of this project.

Public Works selected Welty Engineering, Inc. to provide all-inclusive engineering services. On December 10, 2013, the Board approved the award of a contract to Welty Engineering, Inc. (Consultant) for \$56,553. The Consultant's budget was based on the assumption that the additional 61 new services could be constructed within the capacity of the existing sewer and electrical systems.

Once the Consultant performed analysis of the existing infrastructure, it was determined that the existing sewer and electrical infrastructures are not capable of supporting the intended Project improvements. This created a need to significantly increase the Project's design and construction scope. On February 3, 2015, the Board approved an amendment to the Consultant's contract, increasing the contract budget to \$206,074.

The originally approved PFF funding, in the amount of \$1,899,740, was not sufficient to fully fund the Project's expanded scope. On July 16, 2015, the PFF Committee reviewed and recommended approving the request for additional funds in the amount of \$1,256,634, based on Parks Master Plan to develop more facilities as the population increased. The additional funds brought the total amount of PFF funds approved for this Project to \$3,156,374, which includes various other expenditures summarized below.

Stanislaus County is the lead agency for the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) and the project is exempt from CEQA, Class I, California Code of Regulations, Title 14,§15301 (Existing Facilities) and §15302 (Replace and Reconstruction).

Construction of the Project is planned to commence in January 2016.

#### **POLICY ISSUES:**

The recommended actions support the Board's priorities of A Safe Community, A Healthy Community, A Well Planned Infrastructure System, and the Efficient Delivery of Public Services, by providing and improving recreational resources, facilities, and expanding their sewer and electrical infrastructures.

## **STAFFING IMPACT:**

Oversight of this project is performed by current staffing levels within Parks and Public Works Departments.


