Approval to Set a Public Hearing on March 1, 2016 at 9:05 a.m., to Consider an Appeal of the Planning Commission's Approval of Use Permit Application No. PLN2015-0023, Verizon Wireless – Moffett Road Page 2

DISCUSSION:

On January 7, 2016, the Planning Commission approved Use Permit Application No. PLN2015-0023 – Verizon Wireless – Moffett Road a request to construct a new wireless communication facility that includes a 75-foot high monopole with 12 mounted antennas, 184 square-foot equipment shelter, and supporting equipment within a 1,200 square-foot leased area on a 30± acre parcel in the A-2-10 (General Agriculture) zoning district. The project site is located at 4037 Moffett Road, South of E. Service Road, within the City of Ceres' Sphere of Influence. APN: 041-011-012.

An appeal of the Planning Commission decision was submitted by Mackenzie & Albritton LLP, on behalf of their client, Verizon Wireless. In accordance with Stanislaus County Code Section 21.112.040, all appeals of the Stanislaus County Planning Commission's Decision are filed with the Stanislaus County Board of Supervisors. Upon receiving an appeal, the Board of Supervisors places an item setting a public hearing date and time on their agenda for consideration. Once a public hearing date is approved, the Clerk of the Board is required to publish a Notice of Public Hearing in a newspaper of general circulation. The Planning and Community Development Department notifies surrounding property owners by mail, and prepares the public hearing agenda item.

At this time, this item simply sets the date and time for a hearing on the matter before the Board of Supervisors to consider the appeal.

POLICY ISSUES:

Setting a public hearing to consider an appeal of the Planning Commission's decision is consistent with the Board's priority of A Well-Planned Infrastructure System.



Dear Honorable Members of the Board of Supervisors:

We write to you on behalf of our client Verizon Wireless in order to appeal Condition 22 of the approval of the above-referenced Verizon Wireless facility (the "Approved Facility") by the Stanislaus County Planning Commission on January 7, 2016. The Approved Facility is located within the sphere of influence of the City of Ceres (the "City"). Condition 22 was added by the Planning Commission to its approval at the request of the City and unreasonably limits the term of Verizon Wireless' permit to 10 years. In order to justify its investment in wireless services in Stanislaus County, Verizon Wireless seeks a minimum 20-year term for the Approved Facility.

Initially, the City did not support Verizon Wireless's application, stating that the location of the Approved Facility "has a General Plan designation of residential" and "the City's zoning code does not permit cell towers in residential areas." In response, Verizon Wireless argued that while the City's General Plan Land Use Diagram does designate the Application location as intended for high-density residential, this designation does not in any manner preclude placement of a telecommunication facility under the City's General Plan. Further, the broad prohibition of wireless facilities in residential zones violates federal law.

The City's proposed annexation of areas south of the city limits and west of Highway 99 near the Approved Facility is highly speculative and not presently anticipated. Even if annexed, zoned and developed, there is no justification for excluding

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wireless facilities from residential zones. Verizon Wireless agreed to compromise on a form of Condition 22 allowing annexation of the Approved Facility location by the City, but cannot agree to the limited 10-year term. Verizon Wireless asks that the Board of Supervisors extend the minimum term under Condition 22 up to 20 years. This will allow Verizon Wireless to install the Approved Facility and provide needed wireless service to this important stretch of Highway 99.

A check in the amount of six hundred and twenty-two dollars for payment of the appeal fee is attached to this letter. Thank you for your careful consideration of this appeal.
