SUBJECT:

Approval to Issue a Request for Proposals for a First Responder Distributed Antenna System at the AB 900 Public Safety Expansion Projects One and Three.

STAFF RECOMMENDATIONS:

1. Authorize the Project Manager for AB 900 Project One and Project Three to issue a Request for Proposals for a First Responder Distributed Antenna System at the AB 900 Public Safety Center Expansion Projects One and Three.

DISCUSSION:

The current Public Safety Center facility uses a Distributed Antenna System (DAS). The system needs to be expanded into the new AB 900 Projects One and Three. The AB900 Projects One and Three are funded ninety percent by the State of California and ten percent by Stanislaus County.

The First Responder Distributed Antenna (DAS) System expansion will be designed using the existing Public Safety Center radio communication equipment and will function throughout the entire facility ensuring effective communication by staff working at the facility.

POLICY ISSUE:

This item supports continuity in the Sheriff's Office communication systems.

FISCAL IMPACT:

The AB 900 Public Safety Expansion Projects One and Three are well on their way towards completion. The Projects are currently on time and under budget. The current radio system will need to be expanded into AB 900 Project One and Project Three. Funding for this item is included within the AB 900 budget which is funded ninety percent by the State of California and ten percent by Stanislaus County.
