Approval of Agreements for Behavioral Health & Recovery Services for Fiscal Year 2016-2017 for the Provision of Mental Health, Alcohol and Drug, and Ancillary Services

STAFF RECOMMENDATIONS:

- 1. Approve the agreements with service providers for Behavioral Health & Recovery Services effective July 1, 2016 for Fiscal Year 2016-2017 as reflected in this agenda item.
- 2. Authorize the Behavioral Health Director, or her designee, to sign the agreements for Fiscal Year 2016-2017 as reflected in this agenda item.
- 3. Authorize the Behavioral Health Director, or designee, to negotiate and sign amendments to all agreements discussed in this agenda item, as Attachment A, to add services and payment for services up to \$75,000 per agreement, budget permitting, throughout the Fiscal Year 2016-2017.
- 4. Authorize the Behavioral Health Director, or designee, to negotiate and sign amendments to all agreements discussed in this agenda item, as Attachment B, to add services and payment for services up to \$25,000 per agreement, budget permitting, throughout the Fiscal Year 2016-2017.

DISCUSSION:

Behavioral Health and Recovery Services contracts with numerous individuals and agencies for the provision of mental health, alcohol and other drug, and ancillary services to Stanislaus County residents. In most cases, individuals and agencies are selected through a competitive process, which takes into account specific expertise, as well as cost efficiency. Agreements are renewed based on a demonstrated ability to deliver required outcomes effectively, along with availability of funding. While a number of agencies have successful, long term partnering relationships with Behavioral Health and Recovery Services, all applicable provider agreements will continue to be reviewed and competitive bids will be sought periodically, consistent with Board of Supervisors' direction.

Behavioral Health and Recovery Services experiences occasional funding opportunities and unanticipated increases in the utilization of services throughout the year. On many occasions, this additional funding is time sensitive. For this reason, the Department requests authorization for the Behavioral Health Director, or designee, to negotiate and execute amendments, when necessary, up to \$75,000 to the agreements listed in Attachment A of this

agenda item without further action by the Board of Supervisors, throughout Fiscal Year 2016-2017. Attachment A includes those agreements that have a cumulative value that exceeds \$100,000, for the period beginning July 1, 2014 through June 30, 2017, as required in Contract Reporting Policy Number One, originally approved by the Board on January 24, 2006 and modified by the Board on March 22, 2011. Any amendments to these agreements will be identified in subsequent quarterly financial reports to the Board of Supervisors.

In addition, County departments are required to provide a quarterly report to the Board of Supervisors for any agreement entered into, where the compensation exceeds \$50,000 but does not exceed \$100,000, and the contract has not been previously approved by the Board of Supervisors. Attachment B identifies these agreements.

The Department requests authorization for the Behavioral Health Director, or her designee, to negotiate and execute amendments, when necessary, up to \$25,000 to all agreements listed in Attachment B of this agenda item without further action by the Board of Supervisors, throughout Fiscal Year 2016-2017. Any amendments to these agreements will be identified in subsequent quarterly financial reports to the Board of Supervisors.

POLICY ISSUE:

As noted above, Contract Reporting Policy Number One was revised to read

"Departments are required to obtain approval by the Board of Supervisors for any contract or agreement where the total cumulative compensation exceeds \$100,000. For purposes of this policy, cumulative refers to the total compensation paid by an individual department in the reporting year and the two fiscal years immediately prior thereto, where there has been no break in contractual services over 6 months."

This agenda item is in compliance with this policy. It is also essential that the agreements in this agenda item be fully executed before July 1, 2016 to avoid disruption of critical services to the residents of Stanislaus County.

FISCAL IMPACT:

The Behavioral Health and Recovery Services Proposed Budget for Fiscal Year 2016-2017 includes funding in the amount of \$41,268,254 for the agreements listed in this agenda item. The total amount of contracts over \$100,000 cumulatively, to be approved by the Board of Supervisors through this agenda item is \$40,649,114 for Fiscal Year 2016-2017. The total amount of contracts over \$50,000 cumulatively but under \$100,000 over this time period is \$619,140.

Funding for these contracts comes from 13 different sources. They are 1991 Realignment, 2011 Realignment, Mental Health Services Act (MHSA), federal block grants (2), Proposition 10 revenue, Federal Financial Participation, inter-department agreements, court fines, AB 109, Early Headstart, patient fees, and County General Fund. The County General Fund pays for \$25,980 in services associated with the Public Guardian.
