STAFF RECOMMENDATIONS:

Set a public hearing for June 28, 2016 at 9:10 a.m. to consider approval of Williamson Act Cancellation Application No. PLN2016-0046, McHenry Bridge, a request to cancel a portion of Williamson Act Contract No.75-1846, as a part of the Stanislaus County Public Works Department's McHenry Bridge Improvement Project.
- 2. Authorize the Clerk of the Board to publish notice of hearing as required by law.

DISCUSSION:

This is a request to set a public hearing for June 28, 2016 at 9:10 a.m. to consider approval of Williamson Act Cancellation Application No. PLN2016-0046, McHenry Bridge, a request to cancel a portion of Williamson Act Contract No. 75-1846, as a part of the Stanislaus County Public Works Department's McHenry Bridge Improvement Project that is being undertaken to improve public safety.

The Board of Supervisors approved the purchase agreement between the Stanislaus County Department of Public Works and the property owner Hudelson Company on April 21, 2015 (Board Action No. 2015-159). The McHenry Bridge was built in 1959 and consists of a concrete slab foundation over the overflow banks and concrete cast-in-place box girder bridge over the main stem of the Stanislaus River. In late 1981 and early 1982, Stanislaus County and San Joaquin County through each of their respective Boards adopted a resolution and agreed to be responsible for the maintenance and repair for each of their half of the McHenry Bridge. In July of 2001, the results of a study conducted jointly by Stanislaus and San Joaquin Counties determined that the bridge was seismically, structurally, and functionally inadequate and recommended that the bridge be widened and replaced. The study further recommended that Stanislaus and San Joaquin Counties work toward the replacement of the bridge. On June 26, 2007, the Stanislaus County Board of Supervisors approved a Cooperative Agreement with San Joaquin County. The National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) process was completed on March 7, 2013, and a California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) Mitigated Negative Declaration environmental determination was adopted by San Joaquin County on February 25, 2014.

Approval to Set a Public Hearing for June 28, 2016 at 9:10 a.m. to Consider Approval of Williamson Act Cancellation Application No. PLN2016-0046, McHenry Bridge, a Partial Cancellation of Williamson Act Contract No. 75-1846.

Completion of the bridge improvement project required additional right-of-way along the existing bridge. In September of 2015, Stanislaus County Department of Public Works acquired 2.33 acres of Assessor Parcel No. 074-001-001 located at 8124 McHenry Avenue. Due to existence of Williamson Act Contract No. 75-1846, a partial cancellation is required for the 2.33 acres of right-of-way. The remaining 59.66 acres of 8124 McHenry Avenue will remain under contract, and will remain planted in orchard.

This item will set the date and time for a public hearing to consider approval of Williamson Act Cancellation Application No. PLN2016-0046 - McHenry Bridge.

POLICY ISSUE:

In order for a Williamson Act Contract to be canceled, the Board of Supervisors must hold a public hearing on the request and make the necessary findings as required by California Government Code Section 51282, the County's Williamson Act Uniform Rules, and the contract itself.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Costs associated with setting the public hearing, publishing required notices, and conducting the hearing will be covered by the application fee paid by the applicant.

BOARD OF SUPERVISORS' PRIORITY:

The Williamson Act Cancellation, requested for the purpose of improving the McHenry Bridge, furthers the Board's priorities of A Safe Community, Effective Partnerships, and A Well Planned Infrastructure System, through proposed improvements to public infrastructure for the purposes of improving public safety.

STAFFING IMPACT:


Responsibility for preparing all reports and attending meetings associated with the proposed Williamson Act Cancellation Application will be assumed by existing Planning and Community Development staff.


