Approval to Rescind a Portion of Williamson Act Contract No. 2007-13, Located at the End of Goodwin Road, Between Wellsford and Albers Roads, South of Dry Creek, in the Modesto Area; and Approval of a New Contract Pursuant to Parcel Map No. 2008-06

STAFF RECOMMENDATIONS:

- 1. Find that pursuant to California Government Code Section 51254 the new contract will enforceably restrict the same property for an initial term at least as long as the unexpired term of the rescinded contract, but for not less than 10 years except as authorized under the County implementation of AB1265.
- 2. Rescind a Portion of Williamson Act Contract No. 2007-13, located between Wellsford and Albers Roads, south of Dry Creek, in the Modesto area.
- 3. Approve a new Williamson Act contract pursuant to Parcel Map 2008-06, Ronald Martella and Williamson Act Application No. 2015-0015 Ronald Martella.
- 4. Authorize the Director of Planning and Community Development to execute a new Williamson Act contract pursuant to Parcel Map 2008-06, Ronald Martella and Williamson Act Application No. 2015-0015 Ronald Martella.

DISCUSSION:

This is a request to rescind a portion of Williamson Act Contract No. 2007-13 in order to facilitate the Conditions of Approval for Parcel Map Application No. 2008-06 – Ronald Martella, approved by the Stanislaus County Planning Commission on September 4, 2008. The parcel map requested to divide two parcels totaling 166.2 acres into four parcels of approximately 40 acres each, in the A-2-40 (General Agriculture) zoning district. The property is located at the north end of Goodwin Road, between Wellsford and Albers Roads, south of Dry Creek, in the Modesto area. Only a portion of the Parcel Map project site, 103.3 of 166.2 acres, is enrolled under a Williamson Act Contract and, as such, the following Condition of Approval was added to the project:

8. Prior to recording of the final map, the Williamson Act Contract must be tentatively approved by the Board of Supervisors. The applicant is required to record the Williamson Act Contract for Parcel 3 concurrent with the recording of the final map.

Without the Condition of Approval, proposed Parcel No. 3 would only be partially enrolled

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under contract. Proposed Parcels No. 1 and 2 are completely enrolled under existing Contract No. 2007-13 and proposed Parcel No. 4 is not enrolled under a contract.

Consequently, this request would rescind the portion of Contract No. 2007-13 covering the Parcel Map project site and enroll the entire Parcel Map project site into a single new Williamson Act Contract. The approved Tentative Parcel Map is provided as Attachment "1" of this report and the entire Planning Commission staff report is available online at: http://www.stancounty.com/planning/agenda/2008/09-18-08/Martella%20SR.pdf

California Government Code Section 51254 allows for parties to rescind a contract in order to simultaneously enter into a new contract pursuant to the Williamson Act, provided the new contract enforceably restricts the same property for an initial term at least as long as the unexpired term of the contract being rescinded.

The proposed action will increase the number of acres enrolled under a Williamson Act contract from 103.3 to 166.2 acres, and will not compromise the continued agricultural use of the parcels.

New Williamson Act contracts would typically come before the Board once a year, in December; however, because this action is related to a Parcel Map, it is prudent to act on this action independently of other Williamson Act contracts. As in the case with all Williamson Act contracts in Stanislaus County, the new contract will be subject to the provisions of AB1265.

POLICY ISSUES:

The General Plan Land Use and Agricultural Elements both encourage the use of the Williamson Act to help conserve agriculture as the primary industry of the County. This request supports the creation of parcels meeting State and County criteria for parcel sizes supporting continued agricultural use.

FISCAL IMPACT:

All costs associated with this item are included in the Williamson Act Contract application fee. It is anticipated that there will be no net change in property tax or other revenue associated with this action.

BOARD OF SUPERVISORS' PRIORITY:

Approval of this action supports the Board's priority of A Strong Agricultural Economy/Heritage by establishing parcels that are consistent with the County General Plan, County Zoning Ordinance, and locally adopted Williamson Act Uniform Rules.

STAFFING IMPACT:

There are no staffing impacts associated with this item.
