Approval to Adopt the California Environmental Quality Act Initial Study Mitigated Negative Declaration for the Claribel Road at Roselle Avenue Intersection Road Widening Project

Pursuant to CEQA, Public Works staff have prepared and circulated an Initial Study/Mitigated Negative Declaration to various agencies and to the public. The public comment period closed July 25, 2016. Staff has received a comment letter from Central Valley Regional Water Quality Control Board. Responses to these comments can be found in the Response to Public Comments letter.

Upon adoption of the Mitigated Negative Declaration and Caltrans' approval of the National Environmental Policy Act compliance, Public Works will continue with the final design of the project. Construction is anticipated to begin in the spring of 2018.

POLICY ISSUE:

Per CEQA Guidelines Section 15074(B), the Board of Supervisors is required to adopt the Initial Study/Mitigated Negative Declaration prior to filing a Notice of Determination.

FISCAL IMPACT:

The cost to file the Initial Study/Mitigated Negative Declaration is \$2,267 (\$2,210 filing, \$57 administrative fee). Fees will be paid through the Congestion Mitigation and Air Quality Improvement (CMAQ) Program and are included in the Fiscal Year 2016-2017 Road Projects Budget.
