

ORDINANCE NO. C.S. 1184

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 18.06.070
PERTAINING TO ANIMALS IN PARKS**

The Board of Supervisors of the County of Stanislaus, State of California, do ordain as follows:

Section 1: Chapter 18.06.070 of the Stanislaus County code is amended to read as follows:

"A. Every individual with a disability has the right to be accompanied by a service animal especially trained for the purpose, in places generally open to the public without being required to pay an extra charge for the service animal. However, the individual shall be liable for any damage done to the premises or facilities by his or her animal.

"B. Any animal, including a service animal, may be excluded from the park if that animal's behavior poses a direct threat to the health or safety of others.

"C. Authorized employees may refuse admittance or require removal of any animal.

"D. Dogs must be kept on a leash at all times, except in designated areas.

"E. A stake leash shall be no more than ten feet.

"F. A walking leash shall be no longer than six feet.

"G. The preceding leash requirement shall not apply to dog training permittees who are operating in areas designated by the director of parks and recreation or authorized officer for dog training.

"H. Any animal must be kept under full control at all times.

"I. All owners or handlers shall be responsible to retrieve and properly dispose of fecal material in a sanitary manner."

Section 2: This ordinance shall take effect thirty (30) days from and after the date of its passage and before the expiration of fifteen (15) days after its passage it shall be published once, with the names of the members voting for and against the same, in the Modesto Bee, a newspaper published in the County of Stanislaus, State of California.



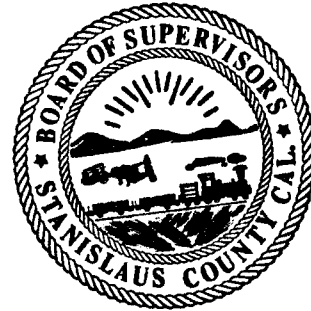
