NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY TO COMMENT, PUBLIC HEARING, AND FILING¹

Concerning

An Amendment to the Water Quality Control Plans for the Sacramento River and San Joaquin River Basins and the Tulare Lake Basin to Incorporate a Process into the Basin Plans for Determining Appropriate Designation and Level of Protection of Municipal and Domestic Supply (MUN) in Agriculturally Dominated Water Bodies

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT the Central Valley Water Board will accept comments regarding a proposed amendment (the "Proposed Amendment") to the Water Quality Control Plans for the Sacramento River and San Joaquin River Basins and the Tulare Lake Basin (Basin Plans). The Proposed Amendment will establish a region-wide process for evaluating the Municipal and Domestic Supply (MUN) beneficial use in agriculturally dominated surface water bodies.

The Board's Basin Planning Program is considered a certified regulatory program, which means that the Board is exempt from the requirement to prepare an environmental impact report for basin planning activities under the California Environmental Quality Act. (Pub. Res. Code, § 21080.5; Cal. Code Regs., tit. 14, § 15251(g).) The Board's environmental review of the proposed Basin Plan Amendment is instead contained in a draft Staff Report, which is considered part of the "substitute environmental documentation" or "SED", and which will be posted on the Board's website (below) along with the Proposed Amendment no later than **23 January 2017**:

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At the February hearing, Board staff will provide the Board with initial recommendations regarding the Proposed Amendment and draft SED. Though the Board may provide direction to Board staff, the Board will not take action on the Proposed Amendment at the February hearing. The Board will provide members of the public, stakeholders, and representatives of other agencies the opportunity to present oral comments to the Board on the Proposed Amendment and the adequacy of the SED. Oral presentations may be limited to 3-minutes at the discretion of the Board Chair. Groups are encouraged to designate a spokesperson and to contact Anne Littlejohn at anne.littlejohn@waterboards.ca.gov no later than 7 February 2017 if they anticipate requiring more than three minutes for oral comments. All exhibits presented at the hearings, including charts, graphs, and other testimony, must be left with the Board and will become part of the administrative record. Following the February hearing, Board staff will review comments received and prepare responses and final recommendations for the Board's consideration.

At the June hearing, the Board will consider all timely comments concerning the Proposed Amendment and draft SED along with any responses provided by Board staff, and will consider adoption of the Proposed Amendment and SED, including any proposed revisions to either. Oral comments made at the June hearing will be limited in scope to those issues already raised during the public comment period. Oral presentations will be limited to 3-minutes at the discretion of the Board Chair.
